Let's welcome the 2021 Kaohsiung Spring Arts Festival in the post-pandemic era!

Due to the global pandemic in 2020, many programs were canceled. Do you still expect the Kaohsiung Spring Arts Festival (KSAF)?

In 2009, the Bureau of Cultural Affairs held the first grassland concert without chairs at the Kaohsiung Museum of Fine Arts (KMFA), where the audience could enjoy the live symphony on the grass in the breezy and starry spring night. Each year the festival has a different theme content, art form, curatorial team, venue, constantly progressing and attracting attention. In the past 10 years, nearly hundreds of thousands of people have participated in the festival, leaving their applause and footprints on the grassland and in the exhibition hall.

The KSAF is entering its 12th year. 2021 KSAF is curated around the three primary colors, just as spring brings all kinds of rich possibilities and colors. It also represents the momentum of starting again, such as the revival of all things in early spring. We will not be defeated by the epidemic. We will seize the opportunity of every performance to show the more vigorous energy after a year's rest, and bring the wonderful and different experience to the audience again!

As an important performance venue of KSAF over the years, we also repositioned the KMFA as more than just a gallery. Apart from visiting exhibitions, what else can an art gallery do? We believe that the museum is more than just a space for displaying works. We hope that every detail arranged by the museum can make the audience feel beauty and comfort and want to make the beauty and comfort a part of their daily life.

Therefore, on the occasion of the 2021 KSAF and the reopening of the KMAF, we invite you to bring your tent and camp out for a night in the 40-hectare grassland surrounding the museum. Let's fall asleep under the starry night sky, wake up in the green art park, and make the KMAF not only an art museum.

From February to July, the KSAF will let the participants wave goodbye to the haze of the pandemic and regain their long-lost affection for arts. People can listen to music on the grass, spend a night in the art museum, and watch performances in the halls. In the spring of 2021, we welcome you to experience the beauty of arts in Kaohsiung.

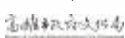

**The people of Kaohsiung built
their harbor with
music over the past century.**

One hundred years ago, the city prospered due to Japan's Southern Expansion Doctrine. During the past century, the port area grew with the export and entrepot trade, but it also faced new problems over time. Over the past 20 years, Kaohsiung has made efforts to change the port city with methods such as opening up space for public and industrial transformation. This process has been made possible by the efforts of many people, resulting in the bright port city we see today. The hub of Asia New Bay Area, the Kaohsiung Music Center is about to open on Kaohsiung's 100th anniversary.

Through a miniature model and old pictures of the Port of Kaohsiung, the exhibition demonstrates the history of the harbor and the transformation of Pier 11-15, where the Kaohsiung Music Center is located, showing visitors how the people in Kaohsiung built a harbor and how a harbor became a city. The exhibition also presents the development of the music industry in Kaohsiung in recent years. We invite you to listen to songs sung by people in the city.

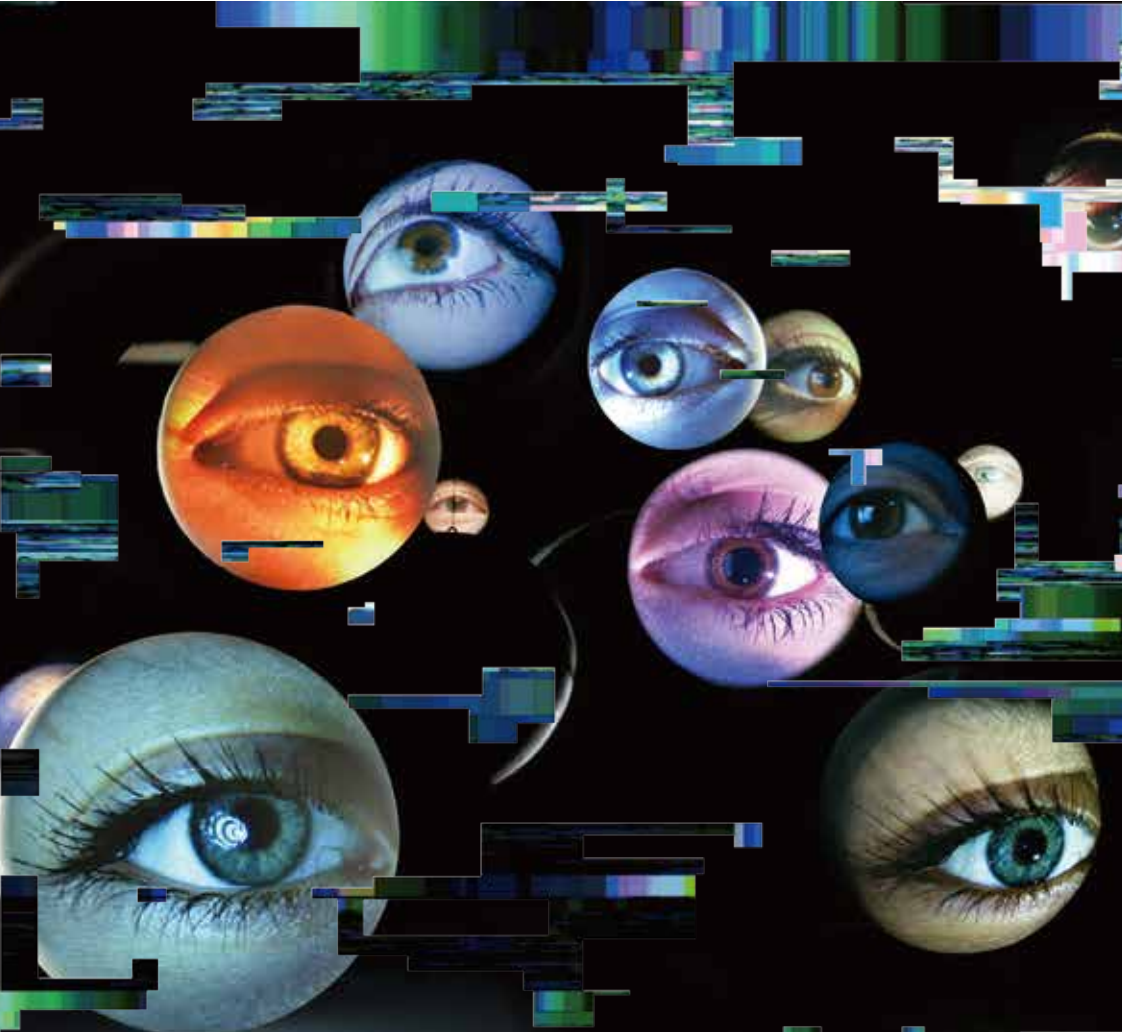

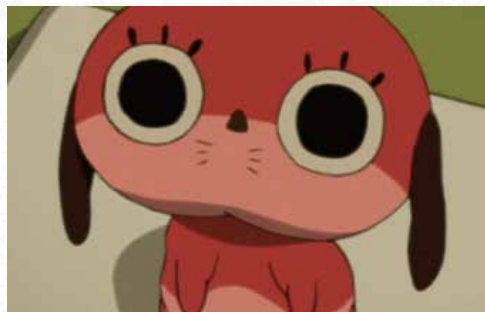

Dayi Warehouse C7: Warehouse of Contemporary Art

On the desks in the ruined classroom of the movie Detention were books and notes of study group members stained with blood. This exhibition also reproduced the glove puppetry scene where the "White Face instructor" pointed a gun at the "Grand Saint Dragon King". The windows of the old classroom were broken into pieces and scattered, and the glass reflected fragments of memories of the leading actor and actress at different points in time. Trapped in a nightmare, the two were talking at cross-purposes and chose to "forget" because of their fear.

The Detention team and director John Hsu used the amnesia of the characters to reflect on a social phenomenon in which people, in modern times, are reluctant to talk about past traumas.

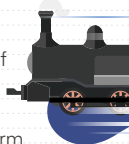

SHOAH—The Holocaust The worst period in human history

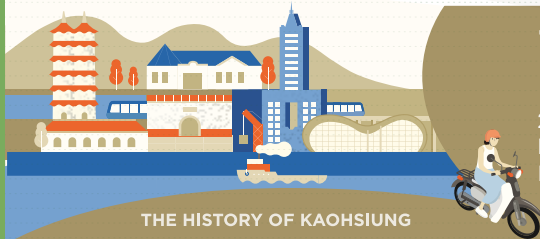
Shoah is the Hebrew term for The Holocaust. The Shoah by Yad Vashem, Israel's memorial to the victims of the Holocaust, has been exhibited in more than 100 places in over ten countries, and will be held at the Kaohsiung Museum of History. At the exhibition, visitors are exposed to written descriptions, personal stories, interviews and photos of the victims between the wars and learn about the genocide and rebirth of the Jewish people. The exhibition means to awaken within the visitor a deep, meaningful and reflective experience regarding the war.

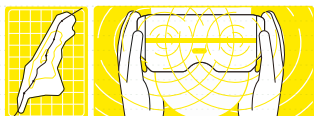
