As the end of the world looms, a handful of survivors live an AI-regulated life in the spaceship "Ark-47". However, with their resources running out, the ark is in grave danger. Scientist A-Kai proposes a "Resurrection Project" in hope of solving the crisis. The basic idea is to store human and animal souls as digital files, in order to enable their resurrection later when conditions improve. A-Kai himself goes into hibernation, delegating the task of algorithm calculation to the AI system. When he awakes from his hibernation seventy years later, he can barely recognize his ark. In the form of a black comedy, this play deals with a familiar sci-fic topic—the possibility of an absurd but pathetic future that faces all humanity—with a touch of humor in the script and the actors' body language.

Go! Cultural Bus Reveling in Kaohsiung

Fongshan Line: A Journey of the Heart - The Fongshan Holiday Cultural Bus

The Fongshan Holiday Cultural Bus covers all the important sites in the Fongshan area, including: Fongyi Academy, Fongshan Presbyterian Church, Pingcheng Emplacement, Caogong Taoist Temple, Chenglan Emplacement, Fongshan First Public Retail Market, Fongshan Longshan Buddhist Temple, East Minor Gate, and Sunyong Emplacement. A professional tour guide will always be stationed on the bus to explain the region's and each site's history, interspersed with witty anecdotes. The ticket is effective for the whole day, allowing the visitors to plan their own itinerary and conduct an in-depth exploration of the culture in Fongshan.

To better prepare visitors for the tour, an exhibit of Fongshan history is installed at the first stop, Dadong Arts Center. Besides a brief account of the local history, visitors can also find useful tourist information here to help plan their trip. Professional guides will be around to give tours and help answer any questions.

鳳儀書院 FONGYI ACADEMY

As a city-designated historic site, Fongyi Academy was built in 1814 (the 19th year of the Qing Jiaqing Emperor) and it is the largest and most completely preserved academy in the whole of Taiwan. Over 200 years old, the building resented in 2014. As well as admiring its architectural beauty, visitors can also easily learn about the Imperial examination system and the history of Fongshan and Fongyi Academy, and see historical scenes recreated using cute figures. Fongyi Academy is the ideal place to visit for people interested in history and also for family trips.

Fongshan History on Display | **Provincial Examination Hall**

In the imperial examination exhibition room, three replicas of cubicles typically seen in an examination hall are on display. In the old days, the imperial examination was divided into three rounds; the provincial exam was the second round. Every three years, it was held at the examination hall of every provincial capital. Thus, every Taiwanese candidate had to cross the Taiwan Strait to take the exam in Fuzhou. The imperial examination system implemented strict measures to forestall any form of cheating. Upon entrance, besides an identity check, every candidate had to be searched and present proof of a guarantor's vouch for his honor. Once in the hall, each candidate would be assigned a tiny cubicle, where he would have to take the exam and board until the end of the exam. Can you imagine how trying it was for the mind and the body? Come and experience it!

打狗英國領事館文化園區 THE BRITISH CONSULATE AT TAKOW

Founded in 1879, the British Consulate at Takow has experienced a number of regime and property rights changes and witnessed the rise and fall of the international trade and fishing industries of Kaohsiung and Hamsen. It is the only existing historic cluster of monuments in Taiwan giving a full display to the British Consular Residence, the historic trail, and the British Consular Office.
