Fongshan Tour: A Journey of the Heart - The Fongshan Holiday Cultural Bus

The Fongshan Holiday Cultural Bus covers all the important sites in the Fongshan area, including: Fongyi Academy, Fongshan Presbyterian Church, Pingheng Employment, Caogong Taoist Temple, Chenglan Employment, Fongshan First Public Retail Market, Longshan Buddhist Temple, East Minor Gate, and Sunfong Employment. A professional tour guide will always be stationed on the bus to explain the region's and each site's history, interspersed with witty anecdotes. The ticket is effective for the whole day, allowing the visitors to plan their own itinerary and conduct an in-depth exploration of the culture in Fongshan.

To better prepare visitors for the tour, an exhibit of Fongshan history is installed at the first stop, Dadong Arts Center. Besides a brief account of the local history, visitors can also find useful tour information here to help plan their trip. Professional guides will be around to give tours and help answer any questions.

THE BRITISH CONSULATE AT TAKOW

Founded in 1879, the British Consulate at Takow has experienced a number of regime and property rights changes and witnessed the rise and fall of the international trade and fishing industries of Kaohsiung and Hamam. It is the only historical site in Taiwan that showcases a British consular residence, a British consular office, and a historic trail, all in one place.

CISHAN STATION

The Cishan Station is the only remaining old train station on the Cuiwei Line of the Sugar Railway. Since 2005, it has been listed as one of the historical buildings in Kaohsiung City. Architecturally, the station was built using both bricks and lumbers in a mixed style that contains both Japanese and European elements. When the Kuomintang government retreated to Taiwan, they re-converted the passenger trains of Taiwan Sugar Corporation with propaganda of anti-communism and reclamation of Mainland China for display as the trains traveled to various counties. These trains would run southward from Taichung for 32 days, stopping at 105 stations on the way while showing movies and plays, as well as giving out free candies.

Transportation:
1. By Train: Take a Kaohsiung bus at TRA Kaohsiung Station. Get off at Cishan South Bus Stop and walk for about 3 minutes.
2. By Taiwan High Speed Rail: Take a "Cishan-Meigong" Freeway Express Bus at THSR Zuoying Station. Get off at Cishan South Bus Stop and walk for about 3 minutes.
3. By Car: Get off at Tianliao Interchange of Freeway No. 3 and drive along Provincial Highway No. 10, or get off at Cishan (Cishan) End of Freeway No. 10

鳳儀書院 FONGYI ACADEMY

As a city-designated historic site, Fongyi Academy was built in 1814 (the 19th year of the Qing Jiaqing Emperor) and it is the largest and most well-preserved academy in the whole of Taiwan. Over 200 years old, the building reopened in 2014. As well as admiring its architectural beauty, visitors can also easily learn about the Imperial examination system and the history of Fongshan and Fongyi Academy, and see historical scenes recreated using clay figures. Fongyi Academy is the ideal place to visit for people interested in history and also for family trips.

The Wenchang Temple in the Fongyi Academy
Light a Lantern, Gain some Wisdom
The Worship Hall in the Fongyi Academy houses a Wenchang Temple, which honors Wenchang Dajian, Kuisang, Zhu Xi, and other deities associated with letters. Among them, the shrine of Wenchang Dajian is an extension of the one in the Tainan Confucian Temple, which is also the First Academy of Taiwan. It symbolizes the dissemination and inheritance of the learning of the First Academy. On two sides of the shrine there are lanterns hung on the walls that are designed in the shapes of scrolls and the academy's main gate. If you have an upcoming exam and happen to visit the Fongyi Academy, come to the Wenchang Temple to pray for good luck!
