The butterfly effect was discovered by western meteorology in the 20th century. Could the butterfly effect, when coupled with the 8th century "Shakyo and Yngst" possibly rewrite the story of fate and create a happy ending? The traditional opera blends singing and reciting. The drama was about an immaculate murder plot stemming from a woman's lust and jealousy. Through the battle of wits between a thief and a judge, and their scrupulous investigations, at last a gross injustice was rectified. The production adopted modern drama techniques, and was also integrated with traditional body movements. It was the first time a play mixed a double act play style with a Taiwanese dialogue, which put a ring into the traditional performance.

Fongshan Tour: A Journey of the Heart - The Fongshan Holiday Cultural Bus

Fongshan Line Longshan Buddhist Temple / Sunyong Temple / East Minor Gate

With over 200 years of history, Longshan Buddhist Temple has been designated as a national historic monument. Though renovated several times, the architectural structure and style of the traditional temple are still well maintained. Sanchuan Hall, Worship Hall, and Main Hall still maintain the original appearance. The clay sculptures, fragmented ceramic art, and wood carvings are full of artistic value. It is not only famous for its delicacy but also its representation of the beauty of Taiwan's traditional temples.

Sunyong Temple is on the right rear of Longshan Buddhist Temple. Guarding a strategic point at the junction of the Fongshan River toward the estuary of the Cianjin River, Sunyong Temple plays an important role in military strategy. With the scroll-shaped decoration on both sides, the horizontal board inscribed with Chinese words "Suyongfeng" is inscribed into the wall.

The East Minor Gate is still open for passage. Originally, there was a bridge named Dongfu outside of the gate. It was destroyed by water and its pier was moved to the riverbank of the Fongshan River. The new Dongfu Bridge has already been rebuilt. Passing through the East Minor Gate and walking through the greenery along the Fongshan River, you will feel the nostalgic atmosphere that the same moon share once upon the ancients.

鳳儀書院 FONGYI ACADEMY

As a city-designated historic site, Fongyi Academy was built in 1814 (the 19th year of the Qing Jiaqing Emperor) and it is the largest and most well-preserved academy in the whole of Taiwan. Over 200 years old, the building reopened in 2014.

While admiring its architectural beauty, visitors can also easily learn about the Imperial examination system and the history of Fongshan and Fongyi Academy, and see historical scenes recreated using cue figures. Fongyi Academy is the ideal place to visit for people interested in history and also for family trips.

The Architectural Beauty of Fongyi Academy's Student Dormitory

Syushe means student dormitory. There are two rows of dormitories on the left and right sides of the lecture hall. There are 6 rooms in each row, for a total of 12 rooms. Each unit consists of 3 rooms with a common living area in the middle, and a bedroom on both sides. As the Academy has undergone four historical periods in the last 200 years since its initial establishment, the Bureau of Cultural Affairs has arranged the campus to reflect these changes in history. Visitors will experience a time-travel like ambience that resembles the past glory of Fongyi Academy.

How to get there

1. By Bus: Take the Fongshan Holiday Cultural Bus and get off at Fongyi Academy Station (second stop).
2. By Train: Get off at the Fongshan Station and walk along Caoping Rd. You will pass Caoping Elementary School. Turn left on Fongming St.
3. By MRT: (1) Take the orange line and get off at Fongshan Station (O12). Take Exit 2 and walk along Guangyuan Rd. Turn right on Caoping Rd. until you arrive at Fongming St. (2) Take the orange line and get off at Dading Station (O13). Take Exit 2 and walk along Guangyuan Rd. Turn left on Jhongjing Rd. until you arrive at Fongming St.

打狗英國領事館文化園區
THE BRITISH CONSULATE AT TAKOW

Founded in 1879, the British Consulate at Takow has experienced a number of regime and property rights changes and witnessed the rise and fall of the international trade and fishing industries of Kaohsiung and Hanshan.

It is the only historical site in Taiwan that showcases a British consular residence, a British consular office, and a historic trail, all in one place.

Wax Statues at the Foot of the Hill: British Medical Missionary James Maxwell

Medical missions were one of the most important ways to preach in Taiwan. The first medical missionary to set foot in Taiwan was a British missionary named James L. Maxwell. In 1866, he built a church and opened the Cihou Hospital which was the first western hospital in Taiwan. According to medical reports, eye disease was the most intractable diseases in southern Taiwan at that time. In order to preach successfully and show the miracle of God, James L. Maxwell left his patient's family and others watch the process of treatment. At the time, people had never seen western medical treatment and were very nervous. Praying for God's blessings, some people thought that if they could recover their sight again, they would start believing in a western God. If you have the chance to come to the British Consular Office at the foot of the hill, come take a look at these wax statues and relive the scene of James L. Maxwell giving medical treatment.

旗山車站
CISHAN STATION

Sugar cane was one of Cishan's most important economic crops from the Japanese Colonial Period until after WWII. The Cishan Line, built due to the Cishan Sugar Refinery, became one of the most impressionable memories for local people. After passing through Cishan, the line linked Jhuangtou and Jousuyung villages in Micaoian. At the time, it also played an important role for children, students, and businesses. In those days, the Cishan Station was the most important transportation hub on the Cishan Line. However, after the sugar industry decline in 1970, the line was closed in 1978.

After withstanding 106 years, Cishan Station was reopened again in April, 2016. Let us sit in a steam train and relive the good times of the former glory.
