Get ready for 2020 Kaohsiung Award

After a long time of evaluation by experts in various fields, we finally picked the final 25 finalists from 438 contestants, whose works will be presented in this exhibition.

The Kaohsiung Awards have entered its 24th session since 1997. The Kaohsiung Awards are the city's honor to the artist, which encourage the creation of artists by giving them a substantial award, together with an exhibition. Each year's winning works reveal a new direction and driving force in the art.

In response to the trend of crossover and then changes in creative methods, the Kaohsiung Awards have undergone many changes. It initiated the evaluation mechanism of "classification in the first examination, no classification in the second examination", and introduced the unique observer system in 2007, which not only interviewed the contestants and examined the artistic trends of each session, but also linked the first examination and the second examination, enriching the indispensable role of the speculative process. In 2015, in order to encourage the creation of calligraphy, it attracted the resources of private enterprises to jointly established the calligraphy and seal carving awards with the HCS Calligraphy Foundation.

The Kaohsiung Awards will be reformed again in 2019, including (1) raising the prize money of the three awards to NT\$500,000, (2) abolishing the restriction on the nationality of contestants to add the diversity of the awards, (3) the original eight categories (ink/guache, calligraphy/seal carving, oil painting/acrylic, sketch/printmaking, sculpture, photography, composite media, new media/technological art) are changed to "calligraphy and painting art", "drawing and print art", "spatial art", "image and technology media art", with the new category of "crossover art", making a total of five categories. The Kaohsiung Awards provide artists with creative options to keep pace with the trend, embracing the spirit of diversity, blending, flow and macro of contemporary art creation, and highlighting the flexible and open mechanism of the Kaohsiung Awards.

This is the appeal of Kaohsiung, a beautiful port city, hopes to spread. With open arms, we welcome a new generation of artists to come here to compete, show great energy, and share their touching life stories with us.

The Only Remaining Pineapple Cannery Built During the Japanese Occupation Period in Taiwan

Taiwan used to be an important producer of pineapple cans in the world. During the Japanese occupation period, there were eleven pineapple canneries in Jiugutang, Dashi District, Kaohsiung. Today, the only remaining cannery is the Tai Rang Pineapple Cannery owned by the King of the Pineapple, Ye Jinru. It was listed as a historic building in 2004. After restoration, it was reopened in August 2018 as Taiwan Pineapple Museum, bearing the rise and fall of the century-old history of pineapple canning in Taiwan and commemorating the golden era of pineapple industry.

As a city-designated historic site, Fongyi Academy was built in 1814 (the 19th year of Qing Jiaqing Emperor's reign) and it is the largest and most well-preserved academy in Taiwan. Over 200 years old, the building reopened in 2014. While admiring its architectural beauty, visitors can also easily learn about the imperial examination system and the history of Fongshan and Fongyi Academy, and see historical scenes recreated using cue figures. Fongyi Academy is the ideal place to visit for people interested in history and also for family trips.

Embark on The Adventurous Journey of Robert Swinhoe by Sea

To Robert Swinhoe, the Taiwan Strait was a cold and unfamiliar place on his first visit to Taiwan more than a hundred years ago. However, as his ship slowly entered Takow Harbor (now Kaohsiung Harbor), he was mesmerized by the view of the green, breathtaking Qingshan (now Traishan, also known as Shoushan), the seabirds flying above the water, and the blue sky. He fell in love with this lovely land ever since.

While savoring the wonderful design of the red-brick British colonial style arched building and sloped facade of the British Consular Residence on the hill, visitors can overlook the magnificent Takow Harbor. Then, visitors can walk down along the historic trail made of coral stone that the consular walked on many times a hundred years ago, enjoying the shaded tranquility. Wax figures and historical stories are waiting for you at the British Consular Office at the foot of the hill. Learning the history behind this venerable building, you can let your thoughts go back to the scenes of the past.

THE BRITISH CONSULATE AT TAKOW

Founded in 1879, the British Consulate at Takow has experienced a number of regime and property rights changes and witnessed the rise and fall of the international trade and fishing industries of Kaohsiung and Hamansan. It is the only existing historic cluster of monuments in Taiwan that provides a full picture of the British Consular Residence, the historic trail, and the British Consular Office.

Revisiting the History of the Shaohuantan
Shaohuantan was a major trading zone in the Takow Port, the primary reason why the port has prospered internationally fame; it was also the place where the Takow Customs was situated in the Qing dynasty, and the location where the first official British consulate in Taiwan was established. The Shaohuan Street, located in front of the British Consulate at Takow today, served as the venue where large ships docked and people loaded and unloaded cargoes. By developing and renovating Shaohuantan and introducing the Waterfront Corridor, Shaohuantan is successfully connected to the historical site of the British Consulate at Takow, enabling visitors to revisit history and enjoy the wide, beautiful views of the Takow Port as they stroll leisurely along the shore.
