From Nautical Exploration to Cosmic Travel, the Milky Way of Love River 2021 Kaohsiung International Container Arts Festival: Van Buren Supernova

The biennial Kaohsiung International Container Arts Festival invites artists from all over the world to present the diverse and complex concepts of container-bearing human civilization in a variety of ways. Artists implement amazing aesthetic ideas about nature, ocean, urban living, space and life development, and reflect on the human environment. Held since 2001, the festival has been highly acclaimed and also created a distinctive urban landscape.

Themed "Van Buren Supernova," Kaohsiung's iconic Container Arts Festival in 2021 will feature exhibitions about light, stars, new life and hope. In response to the new urban atmosphere of the art festival, the fictional Van Buren Supernova from Sherlock Holmes opens people's minds to "light". In the exhibition, containers are transformed into space shuttles sailing through the Milky Way, or modern people's exploration of outer space.

We can connect the maritime characteristics of Kaohsiung Port to ancient exploration of navigation. The ancients sailed far away just as we explore outer space today. The Kaohsiung International Container Arts Festival 2021 is an outpost of the 2022 Taiwan Lantern Festival, also held by Kaohsiung City. So, in "Van Buren Supernova," we think about life, light, and the supernova from an oceanic perspective. The containers are transformed into stars, just like the Milky Way's voyage across light years, connecting people's imagination of a new life with a gentleness enveloped by the sea/Milky Way.

The History of Kaohsiung

The History of Kaohsiung in Animation at the Only 270-Degree Immersive Theater in Taiwan

As an important historical landmark, the Kaohsiung Museum of History serves as the entrance for the public to get to know Kaohsiung. Through the immersive animation theater and interactive display, the Museum demonstrates how Kaohsiung developed from a fishing village to an international commercial port over the past century. The exhibition provides an opportunity for Kaohsiung residents to learn about their hometown again. Meanwhile, it also illustrates all walks of life in Kaohsiung, the changing urban and rural



landscapes and the heritage accumulated over the past hundred years.



Namasia was once the name of a boy who ran up the valley of Nanzixian River, showing us the deep mountains of Kaohsiung. Here the river used to be clear and full of shovel-jaw carps, and warriors chased the Formosan Sambars until the rain gave the land a taut variation and stood up again in the mud. Let us follow the song to find the name of this land Namasia.





From the 1960s until the lifting of martial law, many domestic and foreign human rights workers and organizations actively advocated human rights in Taiwan. Their strength and courage exerted great influence. Taiwan, having gone through an authoritarian history, needs to cherish its hard-earned democracy and freedom and pay them forward.

Visualizing diseases amidst the pandemic

Fluorescent lights are used for imaging in biological tests. The opening space for Question Not Included Exams is a long corridor with black lights to create unreal fluorescent lights. A series of "Dance of Death" woodblock printing by 16th century artist Hans Holbein the Younger is displayed, which depicts disease and death as skeletons and hints at the different appearance of viruses.



In the exhibition's "When We Are Together" photo event, infectious diseases are transformed into fashionably dressed figures posing with visitors. Visitors may understand infectious diseases by tracking "pandemic". Diseases are always around us and we all need to try to live with "pandemic".

"The Yin Yang Sea" He Yu-Chi Residence Project Exhibition 12.18-12.26

He Yu-chi took the "Yin Yang Sea" caused by industrial pollution on the coast of northern Taiwan as the title of the his 2021 Pier2 residence to record the development of Kaohsiung Port after the



1970s, covering six coastal villages including Cijin, Hamasen, Hongmaogang and Dalinpu.

Starting in the First Harbor and the Second Harbor where the ocean meets the island, the artist attempts to explore the unknown and unclear geography of Kaohsiung in the port area of the southern part of the island by using the rare means of transportation between Cijin, Hamasen and Hongmaogang, such as ferries and undersea tunnels.
