

Celebrate the end of the Year and the New Year with the Kaohsiung Spring Arts Festival (KSAF)!


Entering its 13th year, the "Kaohsiung Spring Arts Festival" has nearly 40 programs and 72 performances this year. In addition to the most popular venues such as National Kaohsiung Center for the Arts, Dadong Arts Center, Jhihde Hall of the Kaohsiung Cultural Center, Kaohsiung Experimental Theater, and the KMFA Grassland, the 2022 Taiwan Lantern Festival exhibition venue and the newly-opened Kaohsiung Music Center will be added as venues. In response to the pandemic, international programs will be broadcast on online platforms. Despite various changes, artistic and cultural performances are still accessible to the audience.

After more than a year of intensive preparation, this year's "Kaohsiung Spring Arts Festival" has a great lineup of various types of programs. In early February, there will be an environmental dance performance in the outdoor terrace area of Kaohsiung Music Center. At the Taiwan Lantern Festival, visitors can experience a dance of light and shadow, creating a map of light with steps. The blockbuster "Maritime Glow" is Taiwan's first light and shadow musical, performed at National Kaohsiung Center for the Arts outdoor plaza, one of the two main lighting areas. The play is set in Kaohsiung in the 1960s to depict the history and legends of the island and the happiness and love interwoven by the sea people.

The most anticipated grassland concert will be "That Light in Our Hearts", which has not been performed on the grassland for many years. "Raiders of the Lost Ark", which was canceled in 2019 due to the pandemic, will also be played again. The "Impact Taiwan II" grassland concert will be performed after 2016, and more nostalgic Taiwanese film music will be included in the repertoire. The unforgettable film and live performance by the Kaohsiung Symphony Orchestra will bring many young and old music fans together under the stars and on the grassland.

In addition to the musical programs made by the two orchestras and performed by famous artists, there are also exquisite plays of KSAF and Taiwanese opera performances. The National Kaohsiung Center for the Arts, still a partner of the KSAF, will present many wonderful programs this year and become a huge art forest for people who love theater and performing arts.

Don't forget to reserve time for your favorite programs. We wish you happiness and peace in the New Year. Let's meet at the theater!



2022 Kaohsiung Spring Art Festival Environmental Dance Series

The 2022 Kaohsiung Spring Festival Environmental Dance Series will be held from 7 to 25 February at the Kaohsiung Music Center outdoor performance area! The theme is "light and shadow" in conjunction with the 2022 Taiwan Lantern Festival. The local dance troupes are invited to perform. These include Solar Site Dance Theatre's "Raven", Kaohsiung City Ballet's "City Lights", Blooming-Grass Cooperative's "Tag Along", and 01 Dance's "The White Night".

The environmental dance series focuses on fostering local teams, promoting local team creation, developing the urban environment and optimizing its performance style. The venue of these performances is mainly in the exhibition area of Taiwan Lantern Festival. We hope that the audience can experience the combination of light and shadow with dance and feel the beauty of dance in the living environment again.

Light Up

the Van Buren Supernova

The Kaohsiung International Container Arts Festival is an arts festival unique to the port city. Themed "Van Buren Supernova," Kaohsiung's iconic Container Arts Festival in 2021 will feature exhibitions about light, stars, new life and hope. In response to the shortage of containers and raw materials caused by the pandemic this year, the arts festival uses the image of "absent containers" to preserve the soul of containers through the use of container-like media. In the meantime, the hardness and heaviness of containers is replaced with a sense of lightness that brings out people's expectations and hopes for the future.

The Kaohsiung International Container Arts Festival 2021 is an outpost of the 2022 Taiwan Lantern Festival, also held by Kaohsiung City. So, in "Van Buren Supernova," we think about life, light, and the supernova from an oceanic perspective. The containers are transformed into stars, just like the Milky Way's voyage across light years, connecting people's imagination of a new life with a gentleness enveloped by the sea/Milky Way.

Xiaoyao Villa

A quaint residence of the Japanese aristocrat hidden in Dagangpu

Hidden in the center of Kaohsiung, Xiaoyao Villa is an elegant Japanese villa built in 1940. It was once the residence of Ōtani Kōzui, a Japanese aristocrat. After World War II, the land around the villa was renamed Xingren New Village as the dormitory for the medical officers of the 802 Kaohsiung Armed Forces General Hospital. After ten years of investigation and restoration, the villa was reopened after nearly a century.

The farmhouse of Japanese aristocratic explorers in Taiwan

Ōtani Kōzui was a renowned religious scholar and explorer who traveled throughout Central Asia and Southeast Asia, giving the villa a mix of Japanese and exotic elements. Green walls and glazed green tiles match each other, while wooden terraces, round windows and multiple roofs are full of ingenuity. There are multi-functional areas in the villa, such as the emergency room, cooking area, dormitory and air-raid shelter. The decorations are detailed as the patio and walls with traditional indigo-blue checkered patterns show the traditional Japanese aesthetics. Tourists often have a rest by the lotus pool outside the house, which is also the most popular photo spot.
