A Music Festival about Life

In February, Love River Bay held Taiwan Lantern Festival during Lunar New Year, and in March, it will bring the most dynamic music festival in Taiwan, MEGAPORT Festival. Spanning the Pier-2 Art Center, Kaohsiung Music Center and Penglai Commercial Port area, the MEGAPORT Festival is integrated into the landscape of the harbor, allowing music fans to immerse themselves once again in the spring breeze of the southern port city.

The MEGAPORT Festival is praised as the “music festival about life”. Over the years, the experienced musicians and rookies have poured their rich life experiences into the songs, and each song represents the life memories of the music fans at different times. Golden Bell Awards winner Yang Lie and Golden Melody Awards winner Fire EX., Taiwanese diva Olivia Tsao and Caotun Boyz, the winner of the Golden Indie Music Three Awards Flesh Juicer and Aaron Yan will perform in the festival. The craziest, the most absurd, the most local band in Taiwan, Ugly Sister, and MEGAPORT’s “goddess of Luck” Chua Ku will have a collaboration. Trending Disease of the Year

Disease characters turn into models and take to the catwalk to showcase the most influential fashion and trends from different eras to reflect on the 100-year history of the pandemic.

Who's coming for dinner?

Watch through the peephole to see who you eat with. The exhibition features the cooking of anthropomorphic disease characters. Visitors can get a glimpse of the symptoms, reservoirs and transmission routes of diseases from the decorations on the mini dining table and micro-photography works.

A series of "VISUALIZING DISEASES" design highlights the different routes of disease transmission. Visitors can take photos with pandemic characters, be aware of the disease and get prevention advice to live with it.

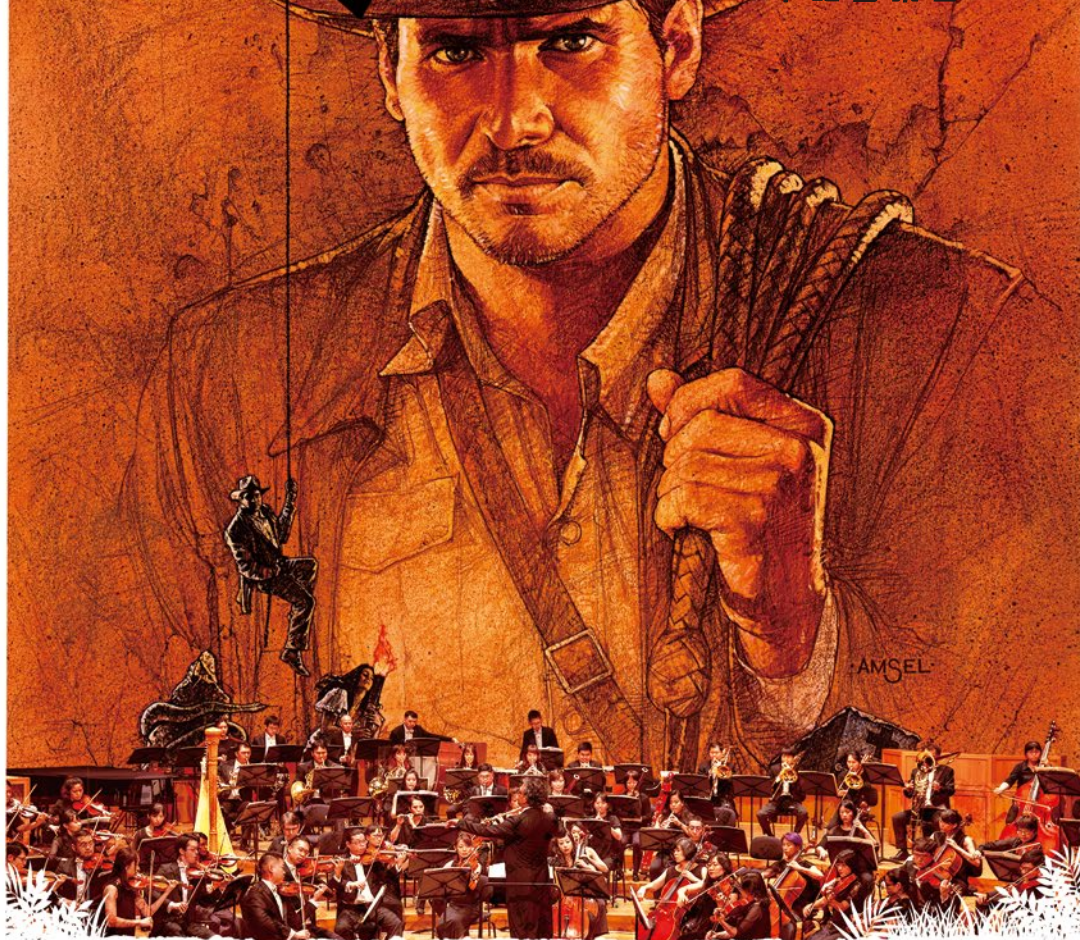

The Magical Journey of Pineapple Fiber Paper



Pineapple, the king of Taiwan's export fruits, is not only delicious, but also can be made into paper!

Make your own paper and write your own wishes on it!
Let children become modern Cai Lun and experience the fun of papermaking.

Dashu, Kaohsiung, has a long history of pineapple cultivation. In the maps of Taiwan in the Qing Dynasty, Dashu had the name "Pineapple Mountain". During the Japanese rule period, the Government General of Taiwan established the "Dashu Pineapple Seedling Cultivation Institute" in Siaopingding, and 21 pineapple canning factories were opened in the whole Dashu area. After World War II, pineapple was still one of the main agricultural products in Dashu. In addition to fresh pineapple, dried fruit, jam, pineapple enzyme and other products were also produced. During the pineapple processing, the remaining pineapple skin and leaves used to be thrown away or composted. The local team wanted to combine Jiuqutang's paper industry with fibers of pineapple skin and leaves to make paper. In addition, by making pineapple fiber paper, the concept of recycling can be conveyed. Visitors may also learn about the time-honored culture of the pineapple industry here, as well as the architectural beauty and history of Taiwan Pineapple Museum.

Happy Birthday Wenchang Dijun (God of Culture and Literature)!



With a history of 200 years, "Fongyi Academy" in Kaohsiung City is the largest historic academy in Taiwan. Since 2005, it has completed the relocation of the tenants and the demolition and repair of the additional buildings, and opened to tourists in November 2014. The most special space in Fongyi Academy is the "Wenchang Temple", a worship space built in the Qing Dynasty, where the statues of Wenchang Dijun, Zhu Xi and Kuixing are honored, and the wisdom lamp lighting service is provided. Before the opening ceremony, Fongyi Academy went to Tainan Confucian Temple, which has a history of more than 300 years, for a spirit-division ceremony. In recent years, Wenchang Temple of Fongyi Academy not only attracts many students to come to worship, but also presents the first standing poem (笺) since its opening and an excellent fortune poem.



Fongyi Academy holds a sacrificial ceremony every year on the birthday of Wenchang Dijun on the 3rd day of the 2nd lunar month. At that time, people who like Fongyi Academy are welcome to visit the interesting exhibitions of Fongyi Academy, besides getting incense bags and wisdom lamps from Wenchang Dijun and praying for fame and success in study.

Do you know that Taiwan's railways have a history of more than 100 years? We welcome you to the Hamasen Museum of Taiwan Railway to see the only and most complete exhibition of 12 railway networks in Taiwan! With 31 retro trains running and 200 famous attractions, the exhibition will take you on a tour through time and space all over Taiwan.

The Dome of Light was designed by world-renowned artist Narcissus Quagliata under the theme "love and inclusion". Located in the hall of the Formosa Boulevard Station of Kaohsiung Metro, this classic piece of glass Mosaic art has become one of the most famous tourist attractions in Kaohsiung. The picture shows the Dome of Light model displayed in the Hamasen Museum of Taiwan Railway. We welcome you to visit the museum and find out where it is.

HAMASEN PIER2 LINE

Hamasen Pier 2 Line is located at Penglai Warehouse in The Pier-2 Art Center. It was the first fixed five-inch gauge railway in Taiwan.

Each carriage of the train can hold 300 kg and is suitable for adults and children. It takes about six minutes to circle the art center on the "Circular Light Rail." The special experience is very popular among tourists.
