The characters on stage are played by puppets inspired by the Japanese bunraku. LEPAGE described his adolescence as somewhat gloomy, so he wanted to look at this conflicting stage of life with a more mature perspective. He believes injecting adolescent memories and emotions into the inanimate puppets will lead to sublimated and honest storytelling. In addition to being a formal experiment, Courville also displays an abundance of technological wizardry. The play utilizes a double-layered platform that allows the scenes to switch smoothly between Simon's basement and the outside world (ground floor, township, school, street, swimming pool, etc.) An adolescent ordeal and inquiry, combined with puppets, stage machinery, lighting, and projections, Courville is an inventive and dazzling visual spectacle.

# 2023 International City Kendo Cultural Exchange Once-in-a-Lifetime Encounter at Takao Butokuden

Since 2017, Takao Butokuden has been under the management and operation of the Bureau of Cultural Affairs of the Kaohsiung City Government. In order to restore the spirit of the heritage site, the Bureau of Cultural Affairs continues to promote kendo culture in cooperation with the Kaohsiung Kendo Cultural Promotion Association. Chen Hsin-Huan, the 11th generation descendant of Japan's Niten Ichi-ryu swordsman Miyamoto Musashi, imparts Budo at Takao Butokuden, making it the first historic site in Taiwan to be reused for its original purpose.

Over the years, the Kaohsiung Kendo Culture Promotion Association has cooperated with the Taiwan Kendo Union and the Kaohsiung Office of the Japan-Taiwan Exchange Association to promote international exchange. In the beginning, the Asian Cup City Kendo Competition was held, which won the hearts of swordsmen. Gradually, it has grown into an international city kendo cultural

exchange, which is an important annual event of kendo internationally. So far, it has entered the 18th year. In 2019, participants from more than 10 countries participated, and more than 250 Kendo masters from Japan came to visit. Even kendo associations from Europe and the United States participated, making it the largest kendo event in Taiwan. The International City Kendo Cultural Exchange not only witnessed the growth and transformation of Takao Butokuden, but also increased the visibility of Taiwan in the international community.

The 2023 International City Kendo Cultural Exchange will be held on March 25-26. Kendo fans from the United States, Japan, South Korea, and other countries will come to Taiwan to meet each other with the sword. The changes in interpersonal communication and life due to the pandemic show the value of kendo's cultivation of the heart.

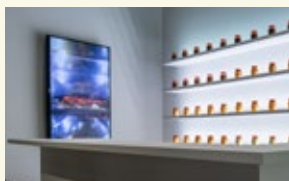

Starting from the word "YOLO", which has been discussed again during the pandemic, this exhibition interprets the concept of "YOLO" from different perspectives through artists' works, and responds to the discussion on the interaction of the pandemic on people's physical, psychological, and social status.

With the theme of "artificial monsters," "QUESTIONS NOT INCLUDED ON EXAMS: The Modern Frankenstein's Monster in Comics" focuses on character design and creation, explores the issues behind monsters, and considers the impact of technology.

Genetically Modified Human exhibits show "dragon baby girls" born in magic bubbles. In the "Brave Animated Series," she is a hybrid character born of forbidden magic between humans and dragons. She identifies herself as a dragon, but has to become a warrior to protect the House of Dragon.

Adapted from the cartoon, the animation focuses on the plight of the dragon girl. From the colored drawings displayed in the exhibition, it can be seen that the plot leads the dragon girl with human and dragon identity to review the history of the House of Dragon, the change of world order, and to understand the inevitable cruel reality of conflicts and interest between different races.



## Ennio Morricone

With the release of ENNIO: THE MAESTRO in 2021, a documentary film produced by Wong Kar Wai and written and directed by Giuseppe Tornatore in Taiwan, film and music lovers will once again be able to remember the maestro of a generation who possessed an unforgettable creative energy.

In addition, it demonstrates the joy of sharing with the nature of public welfare and charity, and root the concept of art and life upheld by the orchestra in our daily life.
