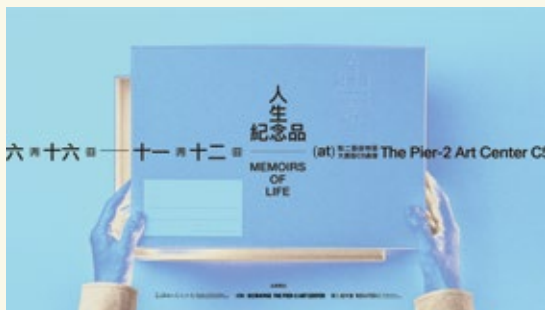

In "Unseen Mangakas | Whose Face Behind Female Characters", eight women characters in anime stories of seven anime artists is exhibited. The female characters in these anime have different appearances and lives. Although the anime characters and the creators are in different dimensions, the thoughts and life of the anime artists can still be seen through the painting frame. Just like the main vision created by popular anime artist Say HaNa for the exhibition, the expression technique of tearing off a corner of the canvas conveys the connection between the creators and the characters, and reveals the mystery of the female characters.

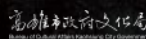

Double Classics**literary master: Marguerite Duras****"In the beautifully dilapidated world, desire and desolation coexist."****Chen Huiying** / Curator, Women Make Waves International Film Festival

Novelist and playwright Marguerite Duras, known as the godmother of French literature, was ambivalent about the numerous adaptations of her work for the screen, rarely satisfied with what others had done. Her first film, *Destroy, She Said*, shows how she reconstructs the relationship between image, sound and text almost declaratively. However, we cannot ignore the way in which her lifelong work has created a constant circle between novel, screenplay, theater and film. Duras's constant tendency to expand, self-correct, adapt, and even create through negation is even more evident in the *India Song*, which she wrote and directed, and *L'Amant*, a novel adaptation directed by Jean-Jacques Annaud.
