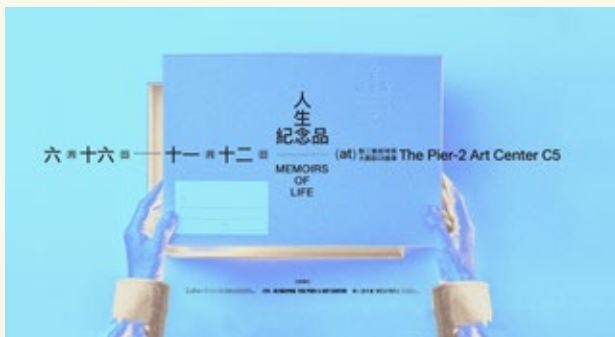

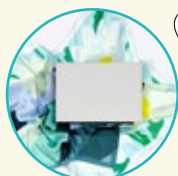

The most valuable things in life are not necessarily the most expensive ones, but those that look insignificant but are full of memories, often the most difficult to give up.



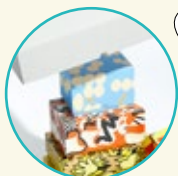

Celebrating its 99th anniversary this year, Butokuden was founded in 1924 to provide judo and swordsmanship training for police officers and young people. The former name of Butokuden, Jhen Wu Hall, literally means to revive the spirit of Bushido. Since it was officially listed as a historical site of Kaohsiung City in 1999, Kendo sports and Japanese cultural experiences have been promoted throughout the year, making it the first historical site in Taiwan to be revitalized and reused with its original functions. Participants can actually experience Kendo etiquette, observe basic movements, wear Kendo equipment to practice the art, and evoke the spirit of the samurai with strength and beauty.
