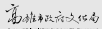

Anthropocene is a major exhibition that tells the story of our human impact on the planet through photographs, films and immersive experiential technologies.

Co-presented by the Art Gallery of Ontario (AGO) and the National Gallery of Canada, and co-produced with Fondazione MAST, Bologna, Italy, the exhibition is a component of The Anthropocene Project by photographer Edward Burtynsky and filmmakers Jennifer Baichwal and Nicholas de Pencier. In addition to being showcased in Canada, the exhibition toured Italy, Sweden, the Netherlands, and Argentina from 2020 to 2023. The Taiwan leg of the tour marks the first inclusion of local artists Chi Po-Lin, Yang Shun-Fa, Lucas K Doolan, and Lu Yu-Jui, who join in exploring the effects of the "Anthropocene" on the Earth, prompting a reevaluation of the relationship between human-altered landscapes, geological variations, and natural ecology.

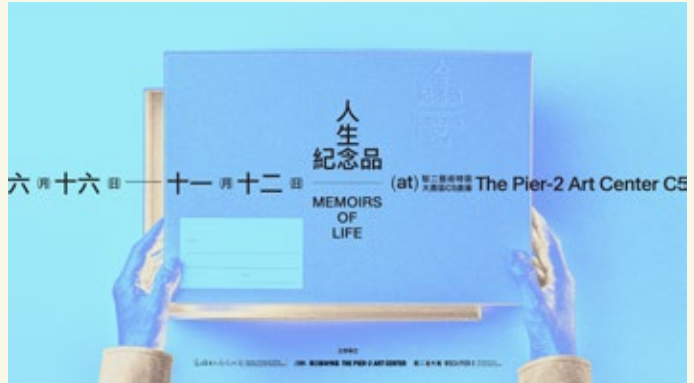

Mementos don't have to be expensive. It is often the emotional objects that touch the heart the most.

The Memoirs of Life exhibition is inspired by the time capsules often seen in movies. Important mementos are carefully buried in boxes that can be revisited years later to trigger important life memories.

24 groups of creators were invited to open the box and share their meaningful mementos and life stories, including grandma's love bento box, postcards written to dead pets, a key to their hometown that they will never use again, and a security blanket that will never leave them. The box is like a time capsule to store 100 life stories interwoven with sadness and joy, touching memories and faithfully showing the taste of life.

Magical Girls," based on the author's military life transformed into the plot of "Magical Girls," portrays the common memory of Taiwanese men with female characters, and features magic wands, costumes, and rank bow ties that echo the uniforms of the magical girls in the comics, with different bow tie designs representing military ranks, and the "magic wand" combat training that is like a real-world firearms drill.

The Jhuang Tou Fringe Festival, now in its 13th year, is a long-standing arts event in Kaohsiung, with performances that reach out to the community and attract audiences every year. This year, we will continue to bring art performances from concert halls to local living spaces such as temple plazas, schools, streets, and communities, hoping to bring the best art experience to the public.

This year's Jhuang Tou Fringe Festival runs from August to October and features the very popular Taiwanese opera. We invited Chun-Mei Taiwanese Opera Troupe, Ming Hua Yuan (Tian) Taiwanese Opera Co., Ming Hwa Yuan the Ri Theatrical Troupe, SanChou Taiwanese Opera Troupe, Sunhope Taiwanese Opera Troupe, Shiukim Taiwanese Opera Troupe and other excellent troupes to perform wonderful plays for fans to enjoy. There are also excellent performing arts troupes in Kaohsiung, such as Bean Theater, Apple Theater, ChiChiao Musical Theater, and Total Musical Theater. Feng Shen Bao Children's Theater, which combines traditional opera and parent-child drama, has been invited to perform. We hope to put on a great show for the whole family and bring a lot of fun to the weekend.

In the "Concert" section, Total Musical Theater, Succession Percussion Group, Neo-Classic Chamber Orchestra, Southern Taiwan Pops Orchestra and Kaohsiung City Wind Orchestra will bring the audience into the lively atmosphere. For the first time this year, a cappella groups such as Fantasia Vocal Band and SONAR Vocal Band have been invited to participate in the performance, bringing a beautiful vocal experience and diverse performances to the Fringe Festival. The "Puppet Theatre" section features outstanding Kaohsiung performers such as Chin Fei Feng Marionette Theatre Troupe, Yung Shing Le Shadow Troupe, Tian Hong Yuan Puppet Theatre Troupe, Kaohsiung New World Hand Puppet Troupe, and Jin-Ing-Ger Puppet Troupe, bringing traditional culture and art into the life of people and reviving its charm.

The Jhuang Tou Fringe Festival aims to make people feel the happiness of watching shows in the neighborhood. On weekend evenings from August to October, the Kaohsiung district becomes a stage for happy gatherings, welcoming neighbors to come to the show and enjoy each other's company on and off the stage.

"Ichi-go ichi-e" comes from the Japanese tea ceremony, where "ichi-go" refers to a person's entire life. "Ichi-go ichi-e" means the realization at the tea party that this meeting cannot be repeated and is an once-in-a-lifetime meeting. In the hot summer of August, Butokuden invites adults and children to experience a Japanese tea party, learn the etiquette of the tea ceremony, and taste the delicious wagashi.



Butokuden in Kaohsiung City, which turned 100 years old in 1924, was originally built for police and young people to practice judo and swordsmanship. Since it was officially listed as a Kaohsiung City historical site in 1999, it has been promoting the sport of Kendo and holding various Japanese culture classes to revitalize the historical site.

Two Classics by a Literary Master: Milan Kundera

"Rereading Milan Kundera in the Age of #MeToo"

Rereading Milan Kundera in Taiwan's #MeToo moment doesn't seem like a good option at first. The writer, who was a member of the Prague Spring of 1968 and moved to France from the Czech Republic, is no stranger to us. We have all heard, "The struggle of man against power is the struggle of memory against forgetting," and we have even felt that these quotes of his have been cliché. When one rereads "The Unbearable Lightness of Being" through the #MeToo filter, it is inevitable to break out in a cold sweat and even feel uncomfortable, wondering if this is the Nine Yang manual of many middle-aged hipsters in Taiwan who are obsessed with sexual misconduct. Kundera seems to be a "misogynist" writer who writes about how narcissistic, sexist, philandering men manipulate vulnerable women.

"A simple joke can ruin a person's life in the brutal socio-political environment of the 1950s."

Milan Kundera and director Jaromil Jireš collaborated to adapt Kundera's novel "The Joke," which became one of the classics of the Czechoslovak New Wave. The protagonist wrote a few lines of mocking political jokes on a postcard he sent to his beloved classmate, which led to his expulsion from school and the Party, and to his being sent to a forced labor military camp in a mining area.

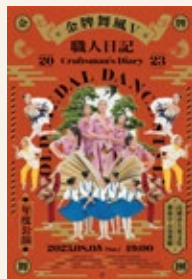

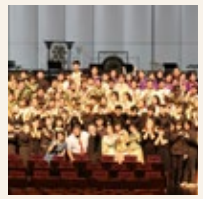
