Film Festival of the New Generation: TTXC Kaohsiung Film Festival (KFF) KFF's New Curatorial Exhibition Crossing Disciplines, Cultures, and Technologies

With the advent of the post-pandemic era and the revival of the arts and culture industry, the Kaohsiung Film Festival 2023, curated by the Kaohsiung Film Archive, will be enthusiastically launched from October 7 to October 22. This year's theme is an almost escapist, yet romantic and enchanting atmosphere at the core of "Boy's Love", embracing a new multi-dimensional imagination of "beauty".

From classic films to Taiwanese time travel films, feature films to short films, long series to mini-series, documentaries to reality shows, from European to Japanese to Korean and Southeast Asian, this year's Kaohsiung Film Festival will offer "Boy's Love" to outline the diverse and full of possibilities world of boy's love. The highlight of the Kaohsiung Film Festival, "XR Dreamland" is Asia's largest immersive and virtual reality video exhibition. This year, it will join the Ministry of Culture's "Taiwan Technology X Culture Expo (TTXC)" at the Pier-2 VR Motion-sensing Theater and the TTXC Pavilion of the Coral Zone at the Kaohsiung Music Center to showcase more than 30 top titles of future trends. "Focus of the Year" features mixed reality experiences where multiple people interact at the same time. "International View" includes virtual reality, augmented reality, mixed reality, remote co-performance and other visual views. "Kaohsiung Original" showcases the highest masterpiece made in Taiwan. The international competition will be expanded this year to bring the world's best XR experience.

The TTXC will use the Coral Zone at the Kaohsiung Music Center as the main venue to host the largest immersive film festival in Taiwan, recreate popular movie scenes, and invite famous speakers in the fields of technology and culture from home and abroad to share the latest trends in the cultural technology industry in Kaohsiung. Whether you're a technophile, culture enthusiast or industry expert, this conference will resonate with you.

The 2023 Kaohsiung Film Festival and XR Dreamland will take audiences beyond vision, imagination and boundaries to enter the most beautiful film world. We invite you to join the 2023 Kaohsiung Film Festival.

Ms. Perfume II

Ms. Perfume II is about awareness of the body and observation of the natural environment. This exhibition invites artists to think about the relationship between the body and the environment. The body is a landscape and is interwoven with a dense sense. People are welcome to experience the interaction between the body and the environment at the exhibition.

Wuba Yang: Wind Walks in Shoushan

Wuba Yang grew up in Yancheng and Gushan, and Shoushan is where she often takes a walk with her family. When she couldn't sleep at night, her father would take her and her brother for a walk along Shoushan. On the way through the mountains to the sea near Hamasen, she still has fond memories of falling asleep under the warm breeze.

In "Wind Walks in Shoushan," she reproduces her childhood memories with three-dimensional paper plant sculptures. The ferns commonly found in Shoushan are transformed into paper sculptures to form a walking path that floats in space. As the visitor moves between the works, the wind generated by the moving body makes the plants flutter slightly, just as she is integrated with the wind and the plants and connected to each other in her childhood, half dreaming and half awake.

Vit: Sleep Diving

The best way to breathe before freediving is to imagine that you are sleeping on the surface of the ocean while the line between land and water is gradually blurred by meditation.

Like breathing into sleep, you can let go of everything that happened during the day in the most relaxed and serene state of mind and body. The brain goes into slow mode and everything and the sense of time becomes very different. The five senses are heightened. The heart rate slows. The border between dream and reality dissolves.

In this moment, the sea is your bed and you turn around and dive into the dream.

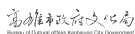

As the experimental result of the first stage, this exhibition will introduce water cups and containers that hold drinking water so that it can flow from the land, through the river, and finally settle in the clay of the reservoir to come into our lives.

During the Kingdom of Tungning, Port of Kaohsiung was a small fishing village. In 1858, after the defeat of the Qing Dynasty in the Second Opium War, the Treaty of Tientsin was signed, opening the port of Kaohsiung to trade. After the First Sino-Japanese War, Taiwan was ceded to Japan, and the ports of Keelung and Kaohsiung became increasingly important for the import and export of goods with the construction of the trans-railway. Therefore, the General Government of Taiwan has carried out two fortifications here. The first phase is a rapid construction with a draft of about 5-7 meters and a berth for ships of 1,500 to 3,000 tons. In the second phase, a breakwater was added, the outer harbor channel was deepened, the inner harbor facilities were expanded, and the draught was increased to 9 meters, allowing ships of 10,000 tons to berth. A third harbor construction project was planned, but it was suspended due to World War II until the Nationalist government came to Taiwan after the war. Based on the foundation laid in the Port of Kaohsiung during the Japanese rule, the Port of Kaohsiung gradually grew into what it is today.



Hamasen Pier 2 Line is located at Penglai Warehouse in The Pier-2 Art Center. It was the only five-inch gauge railroad in normal operation in Taiwan. The small train is interesting and cute, which is popular with many adults and children at home and abroad. It takes about 6-8 minutes to go around the Art Center on the "Circular Light Rail". Welcome everyone to purchase tickets and board the ride.

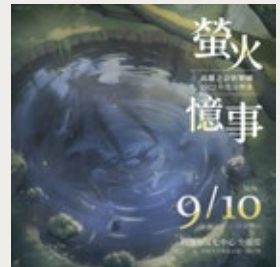
