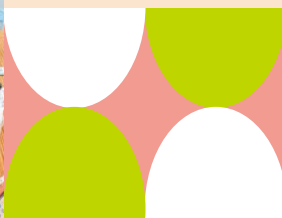

The field also offers unique local characteristics such as pineapple ice products and other highlights. Tourists can enjoy pineapple canned label painted seal jars, pineapple key rings, pineapple fiber paper, and other DIY experiences. The museum welcomes visitors for a free holiday tour. 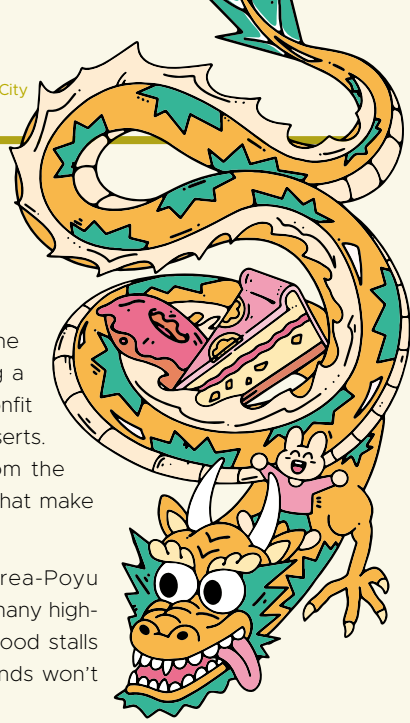
PERFORMANCE

The History of Kaohsiung

Location: Exhibition Room 101-104

As a historical landmark, the Kaohsiung Museum of History becomes an important entrance for the public to learn about Kaohsiung. Following the "Impression of Kaohsiung" technological narrative in 2020, the key to Kaohsiung's urban development will be focused in early 2022 through three themes: walking along the "river" to see the origin of Kaohsiung civilization; taking the "railway" to understand the industrial development and modernization of Kaohsiung; viewing the "harbor" construction to know how Kaohsiung connects with the world. The exhibition hall will be transformed into a landscape space, tracing Kaohsiung's history from a traditional settlement to an international port city.

The lion dance is a traditional feature of Taiwanese festivals and is also well-liked in Japan. The lion dance culture in both places originated from ancient China. As people migrated south to Taiwan and north through the Korean Peninsula into Japan, the lion dance culture diversified in their respective cultures. Although different in style, they both carry people's wishes to exorcize evil. This exhibition is presented in special collaboration with the Himi City Museum. Visitors can experience the unique charm of traditional art through the exhibition of Kaohsiung lion dance and Himi Lion dance.

Everyone knows the experience of a dream, but it never happens at the same time. Lucid dreams are a type of dream where you are awake but in a sleep-like mental state. They are often nightmares. In the movie *Requiem For A Dream*, the setting is an incredibly realistic portrayal of American life in Brooklyn, including the road, playground, TV, TV show, emptiness, wastage, lack, and frustration. *Mulholland Drive* is a highway that separates the valley from downtown Los Angeles. It is considered an 'interzone,' a boundary between dream and reality.
