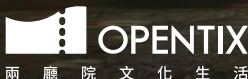

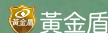

TEMU2000 EMU

The TEMU2000 Electric Multiple Unit (EMU), also known as the Puyuma Express, derives its name from the indigenous Puyuma language, meaning collection and unity. The naming method was chosen through a popular vote. Since its introduction to Taiwan from Japan in 2012, the train has been able to travel from Taipei to Taitung in just 3.5 hours, thanks to its use of air spring tilt technology. It is now the primary train type on the eastern line.



Hamasen Pier-2 Line

The Hamasen Pier2 Line is the only five-inch train in normal operation in Taiwan. It is located in the Pier-2 Art Center Penglai Warehouse group. The train is popular among adults and children, both domestically and internationally, because of its interesting and charming nature. It completes one lap around Penglai warehouse in about 6-8 minutes. Tickets can be purchased at the museum.



Double Classics: Black Crime

A tragedy hidden under the black violence, caught between the powerful

This month, the Kaohsiung Film Archive's Double Classics session is themed "Black Crime." The selected films include Martin Scorsese's *Taxi Driver* (1976) and Brian De Palma's *Scarface* (1983). The characters of *Taxi Driver* and *Scarface* are full of confusion, rebellion, and uncertainty. The former illustrates the profound impact of the Vietnam War on the collapse of the American dream. The latter depicts a violent tug-of-war between the Cuban Communist Party and the United States, while Martin Scorsese and Brian De Palma both explore the tragic fate of the marginalized individuals struggling in the gap between the two eras. This anti-hero, anti-myth, and even the creation of a certain anarchist state are all reflections of the film's mapping of the real times.

Scarface

Classic "breaking" acting by actor Al Pacino

Cuban youth Tony and his friend Manny embark on a journey to Miami, where they work for the prominent drug lord Frank. They become adept at their roles, and Tony's confidence grows. However, his arrogant demeanor attracts suspicion, leading to challenges in his professional and personal life. The film received a great deal of criticism at the time of its release due to its depiction of gun and drug abuse. However, with time, Al Pacino's self-opening "collapse" performance in the play has become another gangster classic starring him, following on from *The Godfather*.
