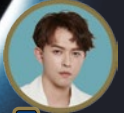

In the early Qing Dynasty, due to the ban on building cities, thorny bamboo was planted as a wall in most areas of Taiwan, including the old city of Zuoying.

In the early days, thorny bamboo was also used as a building material for the beams and pillars of thatched huts and bamboo bridges. The tall bamboo has dense bamboo poles with short curved spines to prevent soil erosion and caving. Additionally, thorny bamboo is utilized as a boundary marking fence plant to safeguard against enemy aggression or predators. It is documented that in ancient times, the Pingpu-Makatao tribe in Kaohsiung also cultivated thorny bamboo around them.

Presently, on Siaogui Mountain adjacent to the old city of Zuoying, there are still some remnants of thorny bamboo, which are open for exploration.

“In the Realm of the Senses” and “Salò, or the 120 Days of Sodom”: Pure Love and Kindness in Hell on Earth

Sada Abe and Kichizo Ishida developed a strong emotional bond that was difficult to break. They were not only physically intimate but also experienced a deep emotional connection. They were not content with an ordinary intimate relationship and sought a more intense connection. What was the significance of the quest for orgasm in *In the Realm of the Senses*, and why did Sada Abe describe the experience as painful? The return of calm decay marks the sad climax of the film. The depiction of the dictatorship of warlords in *Salò, or the 120 Days of Sodom* speaks of the limits of evil in a different kind of human purgatory, an obscene game that transcends the real world but is very real.

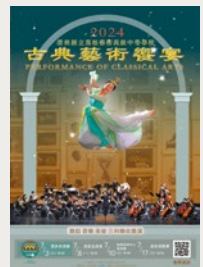

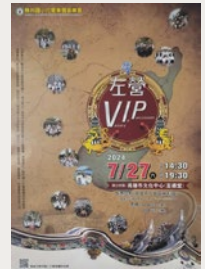

It is notable that, thousands of years later, Cao Cao, Ginger and Yunniang can still be seen on the Tung-Chueh Platform. Ginger is a girl saved by Cao Cao in the war. She is simple and ideal, like Cao Cao, who once took the restoration of the Han dynasty as his own duty. Yunniang followed Cao Cao for many years. She is wily, like Cao Cao, who had become corrupt after suffering human disasters and gaining power. The two women represent the two sides of Cao Cao, while the three souls reflect on Cao Cao's life on the Tung-Chueh Platform.
