## KMFA’s 30th Anniversary Finale

### A one-of-a-kind city experience!

The Kaohsiung Museum of Fine Arts (KMFA) is celebrating its 30th anniversary, marking the centennial of the founding of the city of Kaohsiung in 2024. Following the legalization of the KMFA in 2017, the museum is committed to a new vision and shaping its own influence, to bring art closer to the public and integrate it into our daily lives. To mark the 30th anniversary, the KMFA has introduced many improvements to its services in line with the exhibitions. In June this year, the KMFA and the Tate Modern launched the “Capturing the Moment: A Journey Through Painting and Photography” international special exhibition. This exhibition features classic, profound, and historically significant art that swept across Taiwan from Southern Taiwan. The exhibition set a record of 160,000 visitors on November 17, the closing day of the exhibition. The most beautiful “art club” in the south is thriving.

KMFA’s unique art park is also one of Kaohsiung’s most fascinating urban highlights. The 43-hectare ecological area, filled with grass and trees, is located at the most exquisite intersection of the cityscape, yet has the tranquility of a corner where you can turn off the beaten path and find a place outside of the city. Therefore, we invite you to “OPEN CAMP” and expect you to bring an open heart to KMFA for a brand-new attempt between art exploration and everyday life - bring a tent to sleep in for one night and find your own “camp”; from day to night, turn the corner to discover the healing time in the city, where the scenery is at your fingertips.

Exclusively curated by KMFA, “OPEN CAMP” will, for the first time, open the entire park to the public. Step into four stage areas to savor gourmet food, enjoy music, and immerse yourself in the company of art. The event will feature over 20 camping brands, customized luxury RVs, market-style vendors, and local handcrafted creations in a grand gathering. Diverse visual aesthetics and dynamic musical performances will set the tone, with a relaxed ambiance inviting you to wander freely through the lush greenery. Nighttime highlights include the KMFA Night Walk, Neiwei Cinema’s Midnight Show, and warm late-night delicacies. As the grand finale of KMFA’s 30th-anniversary celebrations, this unique cross-disciplinary art and lifestyle event is one you won’t want to miss.

As we count down to the end of the year, let’s make a promise to visit the city and the arts. Let’s make an appointment to visit Kaohsiung in winter and experience KMFA’s OPEN CAMP, the most fun and chilling event from daytime to late night!

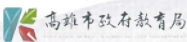

**South Plus: Constructing Historical Pluralism III -  
Ocean in Us: Southern Visions of Women Artists**  
**2024.10.05 - 2025.03.16** KMFA Gallery 301-305

The “South+Special Collection Gallery” is a project initiated by the Kaohsiung Museum of Fine Arts (KMFA) in 2019 to reconfigure and transform the museum into a new-type art museum, redefining KMFA to establish stronger connections with global art histories. The project involves re-evaluating KMFA’s collection to build a contextual framework for the museum’s regional and international art collection and research. Following the first and second permanent exhibitions featuring KMFA’s collection, titled *South as a Place of Gathering and South as a Place of Changes*, the third exhibition, *Ocean in Us: Southern Visions of Women Artists*, adopts a comparative approach to curatorially reimagine connections between the collections of museums to construct cross-cultural perspectives.

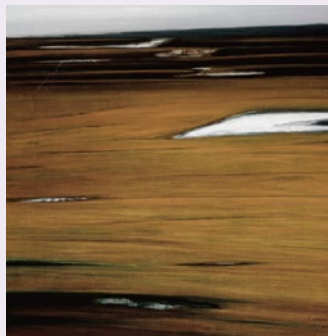
This exhibition is a collaboration between KMFA, the National Gallery Singapore (the Gallery), and the Singapore Art Museum (SAM). It showcases women artists from Taiwan and Southeast Asia embodying diverse backgrounds in the “South” and inquires into various topics, including peripheral histories, gender, geographies, and art practices. The exhibition features stories of diversity, resilience and social engagement connected to the cultural and historical contexts of countries, regions and places. The works display the perspectives of innovative women artists from Taiwan and the Southeast Asian region spanning the past three decades that have shaped contemporary art. They capture personal, familial, as well as transnational journeys that have served as sources of inspiration to this world, revealing the multifaceted and flourishing landscape of contemporary women’s artistic expressions. Meanwhile, the exhibition’s title, *Ocean in Us*, symbolizes a community that transcends ethnic and cultural differences, as well as crosses national boundaries through the fluidity, migration and movements of ideas, peoples and cultures propelled by oceanic and archipelagic ways of thinking, living and understanding the world.

**Painting within Painting by Chen Shen-son**

This exhibition, titled "Painting Within Painting," showcases Chen Shen-son’s artistic journey over the past 20 years since he returned to painting and re-established his connection with his homeland in 2004. Chen not only expresses his emotions through the scenery but also uses creativity to transform and refine the colors and light of the scenery into new visual elements in a painting. In this process, he battles with the unknown and unfamiliar aspects of painting. This is what Chen Shen-son refers to as "Painting Within Painting," the vital source of energy that drives the artist’s unwavering dedication in front of the canvas.



## Contemporary Cave of Curiosity: Snake 2024.11.22-2025.04.13

The snake is seduction and rebirth; beautiful and dangerous at the same time. It can be said to be a combination of god, devil, spirit, and monster, creating many myths and legends. Whether from its appearances, habits, gestures, legendary stories, or metaphors of religious beliefs, it can be seen that many creators from the East and West have been inspired by it to develop works of infinite imagination and inspiration.

Using the snake as a symbol and the cave as a form, this exhibition initiates a dialogue between the space and the curatorial theme, inviting 10 domestic and foreign cross-art and design creators to participate in the exhibition, demonstrating the snake as an information transmitter that embodies the multi-layered relationship between life, society, culture, and psychology.

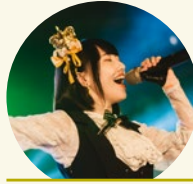

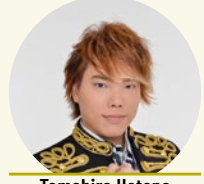

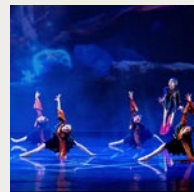
