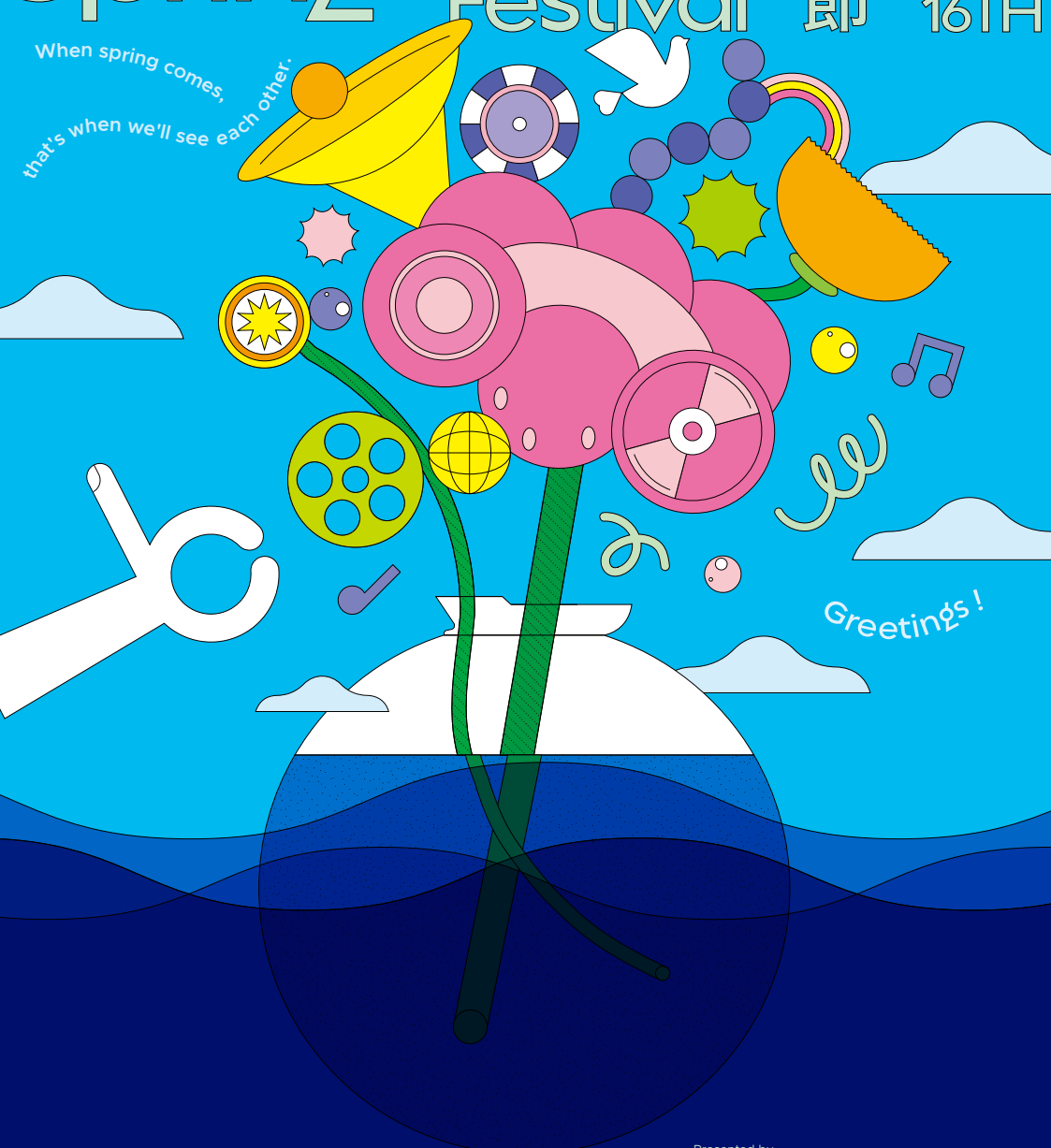

Hamasen Park



Hamasen Park is a popular destination for tourists on weekends and holidays, with visitors enjoying sightseeing, resting, and photography. One of the park's most notable attractions is its collection of vintage trains that have been meticulously restored and are in operation. These trains, sourced from all over Taiwan, are used to transport passengers, freight, and materials, effectively recreating the bustling freight scene that once characterized the Hamasen Railway.



The Hamasen Express, a popular ride on the Hamasen Line, departs every weekend and national holiday and takes passengers on a tour of the Hamasen Railway's centuries-old history. Railroad enthusiasts and visitors to Kaohsiung are welcome to experience the emotional moment when the train re-enters the Hamasen!

Dating machines were invented in the early days of card tickets to quickly print the date and prevent fraud. The dating machines used in Taiwan’s train stations were all made in Japan, with the Tenko brand being the most common. With the disappearance of the card ticket, the dating machine became less common. Today, the Takao Railway Museum stores the dating machines next to the service counter and welcomes interested travelers to visit.

Located in the Penglai Warehouse complex of the Pier-2 Art Center, the Hamasen Pier-2 Line is the only five-inch-track train in Taiwan that runs regularly. It circles the Penglai Warehouse for approximately six to eight minutes each way. The newly designed “Taroko Express” train has been added to the fleet and will run on holidays and special festivals, so please feel free to purchase a ticket and take a ride.



Double Classics: ICHIKAWA Kon

Ichikawa Kon's style is highly diverse, and he began his career as an animator, completing the six-minute animation *Shinsetsu Kachi Kachi Yama* entirely on his own. He subsequently joined the feature film department as an assistant director and directed his first feature film, *A Flower Blooms*, in 1948. He has since directed over 75 films. *The Burmese Harp* and *The Inugamis*, selected for this Double Classics, are two of his most iconic works and provide an excellent introduction to his directing style.

This film was adapted from the original book of the same name by Michio Takeyama. At the end of World War II, Captain Inouye's troops, retreating from Burma to Thailand, were surrounded by American troops. To boost his soldiers' morale and ease their homesickness, Captain Inouye had Mizushima, a talented musician, play the harp and use music to guide them on the road ahead. When Mizushima received his assignment and set out to convince the Japanese soldiers of their continued resistance, he saw the brutal sight of corpses on the road, which caused him to think differently about the war.
