Many creators have drawn inspiration from this, adding snake elements into their works. This exhibition centers around the image of the snake, guiding visitors into a fantastical underground cave.

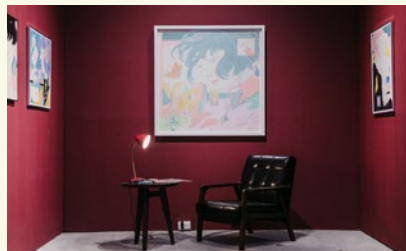
Artist June June Wei uses paper sculptures to depict the Ouroboros, a symbol of infinite cycles and rebirth. The museum provides an interactive space designed for children aged 5 and above and their parents to enjoy together. Through themes such as the "Time and Space Corridor," "Ethnic Stories," "Kingdom of the Mountains," "World of the Ocean," and "City Maze," knowledge of Kaohsiung's history and culture is transformed into diverse exhibits and interactive experiences, allowing children to learn about Kaohsiung while having fun!

Have you ever taken a ride on the mini Taroko Express train?

Located in the Penglai Warehouse complex of the Pier-2 Art Center, the Hamasen Pier-2 Line is the only regularly operating five-inch gauge railway in Taiwan. In addition to the popular Kaohsiung Light Rail-themed train, the newly introduced mini Taroko Express train has also become a favorite among visitors of all ages. Each ride takes approximately six to eight minutes as the train circles around the Penglai Warehouse. Get your ticket and hop aboard!

Two steam locomotives, CT259 and DT609, are permanently displayed in front of the Takao Railway Museum. Both are iconic steam locomotives from Taiwan's Japanese Colonial Period.

CT259, modeled after Japan's C55-class steam locomotive, was introduced in 1935 to coincide with the Taiwan Exposition, making it the most advanced steam locomotive of its time. It was specifically designed for hauling express trains. Meanwhile, DT609, based on Japan's 9600-class locomotive, was a renowned model from the Taisho era (1920) and was primarily used for hauling freight trains. Since the electrification of the Taiwan Railway Western Trunk Line in 1979, steam locomotives have gradually been phased out. Today, CT259 and DT609 are displayed on the tracks, allowing visitors to admire them up close.

In April, the Kaohsiung Film Archive will present a “Double Classics” series featuring Director Patrick Tam’s *Nomad* (4K Restored Director’s Cut) and Director Wong Kar-Wai’s *Ashes of Time: Redux*. These films showcase Leslie Cheung’s exceptional performances from different periods, allowing audiences to revisit Hong Kong of the past century. Both directors, representing the Hong Kong New Wave and its successors, explore themes of visual rebellion, non-traditional narratives, and fragmented emotions, infused with a strong sense of self-awareness. This aligns seamlessly with Leslie Cheung’s unique on-screen charisma, reflecting the evolution of his career and life, and highlighting the enduring nature of his film characters.

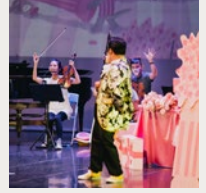
