Opera *Rigoletto*

A Farcical Tragedy of Its Time — A Symphony of Virtue and Vice, Love and Hatred, and the Pursuit of Vengeance!

Since 2015, the Kaohsiung Spring Arts Festival has been dedicated to producing flagship operas that represent the city. Each self-produced opera has garnered critical acclaim. This year, under the baton of conductor Wu Yao-Yu and performed by the Kaohsiung Symphony Orchestra, the festival proudly presents its eighth original production: Giuseppe Verdi's *Rigoletto*.

Rigoletto is a groundbreaking opera in the history of the genre, notable for featuring a physically disabled character as its protagonist. It also marks Verdi's first major success following his rise to fame. The narrative centers on Rigoletto, a court jester whose profession involves mocking the nobility. Despite his cynical exterior, he harbors deep desires for love and family. As fate unfolds, his daughter Gilda falls in love with the Duke of Mantua, leading to an irreversible emotional tragedy.

The opera is renowned for its intense drama and captivating music. Among its most famous arias is the Duke's "La donna è mobile," a light-hearted yet ironic melody that reflects his fickle nature. Gilda's aria "Caro nome" expresses her innocent longing for love. The quartet "Bella figlia dell'amore" masterfully intertwines multiple emotional layers, solidifying its place as a timeless piece in operatic history.

This production features Italian director Gianni Santucci at the helm, and boasts a large cast, including Garrie Davislim, Lai Chueh-Yu, Julian Lo, Weng Jo-Pei, Cheng Hai-Yun, Chao Fang-Hao, Chen Chi-An, Chang Yin-Chi, Wang Yu-Hsin, and members of the Planetesimal Vocal Art Studio.

Through *Rigoletto*, Verdi delves into the complexities and vulnerabilities of human nature, achieving new heights in musical structure and emotional depth. Both the storyline and the music are sure to captivate audiences, leaving a lasting impression. This masterpiece is an unmissable experience for opera enthusiasts.

Hamasen Railway Cultural Park

Hamasen Railway Cultural Park is a popular destination on weekends and holidays, where visitors can enjoy sightseeing, relaxing, and taking photos. One of the park's highlights is its collection of vintage trains, sourced from across Taiwan and meticulously restored. More than 30 retired trains, once used for transporting passengers and goods or serving specific industrial purposes, are showcased in the park, recreating the bustling railway operations that once characterized the Hamasen Railway.



Coastline Sightseeing Train “Hamasen Express”

One of the park's most popular experiences is riding the coastline sightseeing train, the “Hamasen Express,” which bridges the past and present of Hamasen. Operating on Saturdays, Sundays, and national holidays, the train passes by sites like the Old Takao Station Platform, the park's pedestrian bridge, the North Signal Tower, and the Kaohsiung Harbor Inspection Subsection, taking passengers on a journey through the century-long history of the Hamasen Railway. Whether you are a railway enthusiast or a visitor to Kaohsiung, we invite you to come and relive the excitement of trains running through Hamasen once again!



Locomotive Introduction

Steam Locomotive CT259

Year of Manufacture: 1938

Manufacturer: Mitsubishi Heavy Industries, Japan

In 1935, Japan began producing the Class C55 steam locomotives. That same year, to coincide with the “40th Anniversary of Japanese Rule in Taiwan Commemorative Exposition,” the Government of Taiwan imported this model. Locomotive C559 arrived in Taiwan in 1938. The Class C55 featured a streamlined and modern design, characteristic of express passenger locomotives. After the Taiwan Railway assumed control, the C55 class was reclassified as the CT250 class, with C559 renumbered as CT259.

As steam locomotives were gradually retired, some CT250 units were stationed at the Kaohsiung Port Roundhouse before decommissioning. CT259 was eventually relocated to the Hamasen Railway Cultural Park in 2010. Starting in 2024, it has been featured as the lead engine for the “SL Hamasen Express” steam-limited edition of the Coastal Line Tourist Train. With the assistance of a shunting locomotive, CT259 moves along the tracks, inviting everyone to witness its enduring charm!

The Activist on the Buffalo: Jian Ji and the Centennial of the Fongshan Peasants Union

In the 1920s, Jian Ji and a group of young activists committed themselves to protecting Taiwan's rural communities and supporting poor tenant farmers, starting one of the earliest peasant movements in Taiwan. Driven by a strong sense of justice and unwavering spirit, Jian Ji led these youths through rural communities to promote social movement. He earned deep respect from farmers but faced suppression and defamation by the authorities. This exhibition highlights the efforts of Jian Ji and his peers to fight for people's rights and how they built the foundation for Taiwan's free and democratic society.

Located in the Penglai Warehouse complex of the Pier-2 Art Center, the Hamasen Pier-2 Line is the only regularly operating five-inch gauge railway in Taiwan. In addition to the popular Kaohsiung Light Rail-themed train, the newly introduced mini Taroko Express train has also become a favorite among visitors of all ages. As part of the “Farewell, 886 – Cultural Park of Taiwan Military Veteran Village,” the “Admiral’s Residence” combines retro nostalgia with contemporary unboxing trends. This exhibit showcases the daily life of a family of four, featuring their personal belongings and leisure activities. Visitors are encouraged to take “unboxing photos” with the displayed items, creating an experience that transports them back to the 50s and 60s military veteran village. After the war, military families from across China settled in Taiwan, originating from various provinces across China. The cultural park highlights the diversity and heritage of Taiwan's military veteran villages.

In “Double Classics: May 2025,” Kaohsiung Film Archive is showing two of Danny Boyle’s classic films, “Trainspotting (4K Restoration)” and “The Beach,” inviting audiences to revisit two pivotal moments in his early career. “Trainspotting,” Danny Boyle’s magnum opus, has just premiered its 4K restored version at Cannes last year. “The Beach,” on the other hand, is rarely shown on the big screen, making this screening a particularly special opportunity to see it. Just like Danny Boyle’s films, which are always sharp and intense, in a world spinning out of control, youngsters are constantly pushed to make one choice after another, faced with millions of possibilities—willingly or unwillingly. Yet, beneath the seemingly ever-forwarding steps lies a never-ending quest: can we ever truly find where we belong? Where are we being brought to?

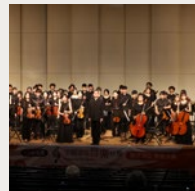
