The “Jhuang Tou Taiwanese Opera” will showcase 15 captivating productions from 7 acclaimed opera troupes, including Chun-Mei Taiwanese Opera Troupe, Ming Hua Yuan Tian Zi Art & Culture Group, Ming Hwa Yuan-the Ri Theatrical Troupe, SunHope Taiwanese Opera Troupe, Sheng Chiu Opera Troupe, ShiuKim Taiwanese Opera Troupe, and Pei-Yi Opera Troupe. These heartfelt performances promise to thrill theatergoers with wonderful weekend nights with famous opera singers.

## Fables of the EyeBall Generation

### When the Eyes Speak and Images Stir

“Grabbing the eye” may well be the most pervasive symptom of our time, pronouncing our immersion in a global visual landscape shaped by the interplay of seeing and being seen. It is precisely this condition that marks the conceptual entry point of Art of Kaohsiung 2025: Fables of the Eye Ball Generation. Anchored in the so-called “Eye Ball Generation,” particularly those born after the 1980s, the exhibition invites reflection on how eleven Kaohsiung-based artists, themselves as digital natives, respond to this visual wave through their artistic practices. At the same time, works by senior artists Ni Tsai-Chin and Lee Ming-Tse are thoughtfully included to “hold the fort,” lending their presence as anchoring forces. Their inclusion creates a polyphonic, cross-generational resonance throughout the exhibition.

Three sets of keywords offer suggested routes for viewing: “Sci-Fi Anxiety and Contemporary Apocalyptic Allegories,” “Polyphonic Clamor ↔ Intimate Terrains,” and “Local Consciousness Mediated Through ■■■.” Invitations are extended to those long attuned to familiar visual lexicons and habits of seeing, those who would like to encounter unfamiliar bodies and grounded experiences, and to step into the visual fables that have grown forth, rhizome-like, from within.

## Hamasen Railway Cultural Park

Hamasen Railway Cultural Park is a popular destination on weekends and holidays, where visitors can enjoy sightseeing, relaxing, and taking photos. One of the park’s highlights is its collection of vintage trains, sourced from across Taiwan and meticulously restored. More than 30 retired trains, once used for transporting passengers and goods or serving specific industrial purposes, are showcased in the park, recreating the bustling railway operations that once characterized the Hamasen Railway.

### Coastline Sightseeing Train “Hamasen Express”

One of the park’s most popular experiences is riding the coastline sightseeing train, the “Hamasen Express,” which bridges the past and present of Hamasen. Operating on Saturdays, Sundays, and national holidays, the train passes by sites like the Old Takao Station Platform, the park’s pedestrian bridge, the North Signal Tower, and the Kaohsiung Harbor Inspection Subsection, taking passengers on a journey through the century-long history of the Hamasen Railway. Whether you are a railway enthusiast or a visitor to Kaohsiung, we invite you to come and relive the excitement of trains running through Hamasen once again!



### Train Introduction

#### Diesel Rail Car DR2900

Year of Manufacture | 1986  
Manufacturer | Hitachi, Japan

The Taiwan Railway DR2900 series is the second model of diesel multiple unit used for the Tze-Chiang limited express trains. It served as an important train model before the electrification of the Eastern Trunk Line and consists of two power cars and a trailer car that provides power. The signature “moon gate” inside the train, which conceals the exhaust and cooling pipes, is a lasting impression for many passengers who rode the diesel Tze-Chiang limited express.



The DR2909, DR2955, and DR2910 cars displayed at the Hamasen Railway Cultural Park once operated as the “Kaohsiung Port Line DuDu Train,” which circled Kaohsiung City from 2003 to 2006. It was truly a pioneer in sightseeing trains. Enjoying the Port of Kaohsiung’s scenery up close on a DuDu train is not only a shared memory of many citizens of Kaohsiung, but also lays the groundwork for tourism and for integrating the port with the city. After being retired, the trains were preserved thanks to the efforts of the Bureau of Cultural Affairs, Kaohsiung City Government. Today, they have been transformed into a unique railway-themed dining space, now home to Horli Baking and SNOW Gelato.

## The Activist on the Buffalo: Jian Ji and the Centennial of the Fongshan Peasants Union

In the 1920s, Jian Ji and a group of young activists committed themselves to protecting Taiwan's rural communities and supporting poor tenant farmers, starting one of the earliest peasant movements in Taiwan. Driven by a strong sense of justice and unwavering spirit, Jian Ji led these youths through rural communities to promote social movement. He earned deep respect from farmers but faced suppression and defamation by the authorities. This exhibition highlights the efforts of Jian Ji and his peers to fight for people's rights and how they built the foundation for Taiwan's free and democratic society.

The S200-series diesel-electric locomotives were purchased between 1960 and 1961 with U.S. foreign aid funds. Among them, S210 was long assigned to the Kaohsiung Locomotive Depot and served as one of the main locomotives on the Kaohsiung Harbor Line. Notably, S210 pulled the final scheduled train on the line, giving it significant historical meaning. We warmly welcome you to visit the Takao Railway Museum and trace the legacy of S210!

Military veteran villages were built to provide homes for soldiers and their dependents who came from different provinces of China. People with different languages and cultures lived together in these villages, developing a distinct culture.

Kaohsiung City is the only city in Taiwan that hosts all three military academies and has a unique military veteran village culture. The military veteran village of Zuoying is the largest and most complete naval village in Taiwan, with a rich history that dates back to the Japanese era. Mingde New Village was once home to many high-ranking naval officers, leading to its nickname "Admirals' Village." What does a military veteran village mean to you?
