Shakuhachi Experience

The *shakuhachi* is a woodwind instrument that originated in the Wu region. It is an edge-blown bamboo aerophone with a wide, open blowing edge and five finger holes. The name “shakuhachi” comes from its length of one shaku and eight sun in traditional Japanese units (with “hachi” meaning “eight”). The tone of a shakuhachi is often described as vast and desolate, evoking an ethereal, serene atmosphere. The ancient shakuhachi was introduced to Japan during the Tang Dynasty of China. It is played vertically, and the type used specifically for court music is called the *gagaku shakuhachi*.

Hamasen Museum of Taiwan Railway has reopened!

Take a close look: in the model-railway exhibition area, several new tracks have been added so model trains can run more often. Many well-known landmarks — such as 85 Sky Tower and the Kaohsiung Main Public Library — have been newly built as miniature models. Come explore and find even more interesting sights!

The Hamasen Pier-2 Line train is located at the Penglai Warehouse cluster in the Pier-2 Art Center. Recently it teamed up with the Kaohsiung Metro Cat Station Master "Mikan" to launch the "Citrus Train." The orange-and-black livery, decorated with the Mikan Stationmaster character, is a hit with both children and adults. One loop around the Penglai Warehouses takes about six to eight minutes — tickets are available for purchase.

Layers of Wanshan Rising Sun: 'Oponoho Village Cultural Exhibition

Wanshan Village, located in Maolin District, Kaohsiung City, was originally called "'Oponoho," meaning "A beautiful land bathed in the first light of dawn." This ancient village possesses a unique language and cultural traditions that distinguish it from neighboring Maolin and Duona communities. Within its traditional territory a precious cultural treasure has been found — the nationally designated National Wanshan Petroglyph Group Site (the Wanshan Stone Carvings Historical Site). Through the community's legends about the people and the rock carvings, together with historical documents and heirloom artifacts preserved by the village, this exhibition will guide visitors through the historical transformation from the original "'Oponoho" to the name in Qing and Japanese era "Mandaulan," and on to today's Wanshan Village, revealing the growth and development of this distinctive people.
