VON WOLFE: THE GARDEN FORTRESS

As Kaohsiung continues to advance its urban transformation and expand international exchange, culture has remained a vital driving force behind the city's development. This year, the Kaohsiung Museum of Fine Arts presents the international special exhibition *Von Wolfe: The Garden Fortress*, showcasing the creative trajectory of British artist Von Wolfe over the past twenty years. It also marks his first comprehensive museum-scale retrospective in Asia. Sharing this exhibition with the people of Kaohsiung reflects the museum's longstanding commitment and professional dedication, and it symbolizes the steady elevation of the city's cultural vitality.

In recent years, British art genius Von Wolfe has attracted significant international attention for work that spans classical painting, fashion culture, and artificial intelligence (AI). With a blend of meticulous oil-painting technique and cutting-edge algorithms, he forges a new artistic vocabulary—compositions that are elegant and refined, yet infused with a subtle sense of unease that draws viewers back for repeated contemplation. Centered on the theme “From the Classical to the Future,” this exhibition traces the evolution of Wolfe's creative trajectory over the past twenty years. From early works that pay homage to classical masters such as Picasso and Leonardo da Vinci to the new visual language he has developed in recent years through AI, Von Wolfe's remarkable creations span three exhibition halls. In preparing for this retrospective, Wolfe undertook in-depth research into the history and culture of Taiwan and Kaohsiung, closely observing the natural surroundings of the museum's grounds. He even incorporated the technological force symbolized by Taiwan's semiconductor industry into his work, culminating in the exhibition's centerpiece, *The Garden Fortress*. This work not only responds to Kaohsiung's landscape but also embodies the intertwined meanings of technology and nature, and of future and tradition, in contemporary society.

Kaohsiung is a city continually transforming between tradition and emerging technologies. Once an industrial hub built around its harbor and steel industry, it has evolved into a smart city driven by AI, semiconductors, and green energy—practical in character, yet rich in imagination. Beyond its robust industry and technology, culture adds meaningful depth to everyday life. *Von Wolfe: The Garden Fortress* is more than an art exhibition; it represents the city's dialogue with technology through culture, and its pursuit of new horizons through art.

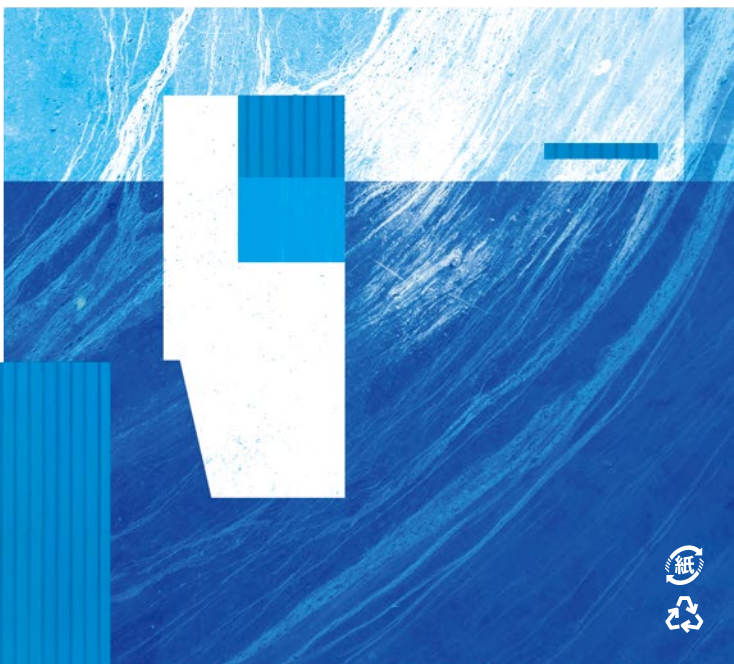
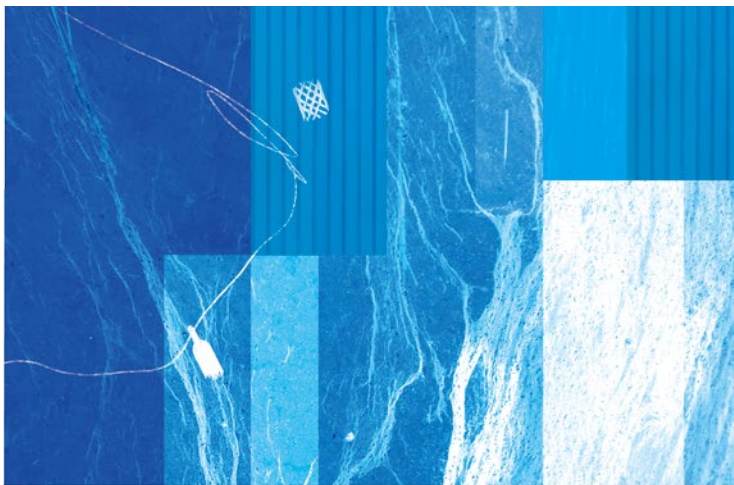

Viewed from the perspective of Kaohsiung, the exhibition recreates Taiwan's railway scenes from the Japanese Colonial Period to the present day, showcasing the history and cultural development of Taiwan's railways. The Kaohsiung regional model was newly updated in August 2025. Come and discover the new landmarks!

The Hamasen Pier-2 Line train is located at the Penglai Warehouse cluster in the Pier-2 Art Center. Recently, it teamed up with the Kaohsiung Metro Cat Stationmaster "Mikan" to launch the "Citrus Train." The orange-and-black livery, decorated with the Stationmaster Mikan character, is a hit with both children and adults. One loop around the Penglai Warehouses takes about six to eight minutes — tickets are available for purchase.

December 2025, it's the end of the year again. You close your eyes, counting down the darkness before the coming new year. In the silence, the smallest sounds become more apparent: five, four, three...two, one! In a spark of light, what comes to your mind? What feeling emerges? 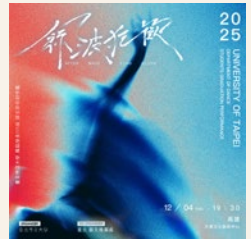

Through the adventures of Xiang Xiang and Shan Shan, we see how kindness and justice triumph over evil, saving not only the world but also every lonely, fragile heart.
