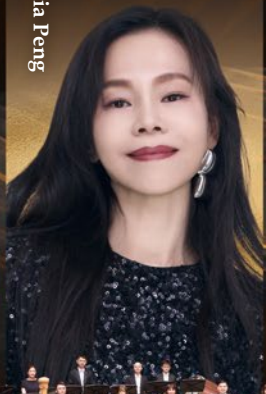

“May We All Be Blessed with Longevity: A Tribute Concert to the Classics of Teresa Teng,” one of the highlights of the 17th Kaohsiung Spring Arts Festival, will take place on June 6 at the Hi-Ing Music Hall of the Kaohsiung Music Center. Conducted by Yang Chih-Chin, the Kaohsiung Symphony Orchestra will perform live, joined by Julia Peng, Olivia Tsao, Freya Lim and Where Chou, who will bring to life many of Teresa Teng’s most beloved classics. From *The Moon Represents My Heart* to *I Only Care About You*, these familiar melodies will be reimagined through the rich textures of a symphony orchestra, revealing an unprecedented depth of emotion.

Thirty-one years after Teresa Teng’s passing, her legendary melodies continue to resonate in the hearts of countless fans. Her voice transcended borders, once connecting households across the island and becoming a shared language across generations. In this concert, it is not only memories that resurface, but also a chance to truly “hear” the legend again. Centered on a symphonic musical language, the concert revisits Teresa Teng—an irreplaceable icon in the history of Chinese music. Her gentle yet profound voice, spanning generations, languages, and regions, remains one of the most enduring emotional memories for many. This performance reinterprets the emotional depth and historical weight of her classic works through a grand symphonic arrangement, allowing these familiar melodies to resonate once again on the contemporary stage.

Timeless classics by Teresa Teng will be featured in this concert, including *May We All Be Blessed with Longevity*, *The Moon Represents My Heart*, *I Only Care About You*, *The Story of a Small Town*, *Tian Mi Mi (Sweet Honey)*, *When Will You Return?*, *Tsugunai (Atonement)*, *Aijin (Lover)*, and *Tuberose*, among many others. These melodies, which have accompanied countless people throughout their lives, will be reimagined through newly arranged orchestral scores and performed live by the Kaohsiung Symphony Orchestra under the baton of Yang Chih-Chin. The performance reveals a richer musical palette and greater emotional depth, inviting audiences not only to reminisce, but to truly “hear” these classics anew.

“May We All Be Blessed with Longevity: A Tribute Concert to the Classics of Teresa Teng” is not a mere recreation, but a musical dialogue that transcends time, generations, and voices. When the richness of symphonic sound meets voices across generations, songs that have accompanied countless lives are given new resonance—allowing the classics to endure while creating echoes uniquely of the present moment. 

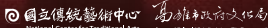

Taipower 2026 Public Art Festival in Kaohsiung | Electri City III—Future: Read Step into the magical Electri City and embark on an exciting adventure!

“Electri City” is a public art brand launched by Taipower in 2019. Combining interactive art, card games, and animated storytelling, it has evolved through its first edition, *Invitation from Electri City*, and second edition, *The Terminal of Reality*. It has established a core approach that blends education with entertainment and encourages strong public participation, transforming the cold infrastructure of electricity into a city rich with imaginative warmth.

Electri City III—Future: Read builds on this vision with its debut at the Kaohsiung Museum of Fine Arts.
